GAME 2 vs. Brandon Wheat Kings Sunday, March 29, 2026

HITMEN HEADLINES: The Calgary Hitmen are back on home ice tonight to host the Brandon Wheat Kings in Game 2 of their Best-of-Seven Eastern Conference Quarter-Final Series. Game time is 7:00 p.m. at Scotiabank Saddledome. It's Sunday Funday, presented by Brookfield Residential where fans can enjoy \$6 food and drink deals all game long, \$3 sips and snacks plus Face Painting and the Fun Zone on the West Concourse. Fans can also watch today's game for FREE on Victory+ or listen on Sportsnet 960 The Fan. The WHL Playoffs are presented by Nutrien. Calgary took the opener Friday night with a thrilling 1-0 triple overtime triumph. Ethan Moore scored the game winner on a pass from Caine Wilke, 5:11 into the third overtime period. Both goaltenders were terrific, making a combined 113 saves. Hitmen netminder Eric Tu turned aside all 49 shots he faced, including a penalty shot, to record his first career WHL Playoff shutout while Wheat Kings goalie Filip Ruzicka stopped 64 shots in a game that lasted 4 hours and 24 minutes, ending at 11:27 p.m. local time.

SERIES SCHEDULE: The Hitmen have home-ice advantage in the Eastern Conference Quarter Final with the Best-of-Seven Round 1 series a 2-3-2 format.

GAME 1 STATS: Ethan Moore led all Hitmen with seven shots on goal Friday night. Julien Maze and Kale Dach were next with five shots each. Luke Mistelbacher topped the Wheat Kings with seven shots. In the face-off circle, Calgary went a combined 68-117 on draws, clicking at 58.1%. Harrison Lodewyk (25), Kale Dach (16), Ethan Moore (13) and Andrei Molgachev (10) all won at least 10 face-offs.

BEEN A WHILE: Friday's Game 1 was Calgary's first 1-0 playoff result in nearly 20 years. On April 8 1998, the Hitmen blanked Swift Current 1-0 in a series clinching Game 7 with that contest needing only 60 minutes. Friday game was also the longest home ice playoff game in franchise history at 105:11. Overall it was less than a minute shy of breaking the club record set by Jordan Krestanovich who scored 6:05 into triple overtime on the road in Kamloops May 5, 1999.

STREAKIN': Dating back to the regular season, Ethan Moore (2g, 1a) has scored in back-to-back games. Ben MacBeath (1g, 9a) saw his career high tying six-game point streak end in Game 1 while two-game point streaks for Blake Vanek (2g, 3a) and Ty Meunier (1g, 2a) were also halted.

FAST FACTS: The Hitmen are the #4 seed in the Eastern Conference after an 85-point regular season which saw the club post a record of 38-21-8-1. Brandon is the #5 seed, finishing their schedule with 82 points following a 40-26-2-0 campaign.

PLAYOFF DEBUT: A total of 10 Hitmen played their first ever Western Hockey League playoff game on Friday night in the series opener. The Hitmen have a combined 118 games of playoff experience while Brandon has 132. Harrison Lodewyk leads Calgary with 22 post-season games played. Ethan Moore with 17 and Julien Maze with 13 round out the top three.

REGULAR SEASON VS. BRANDON: Calgary picked up five of a possible eight points during their regular season series with the Wheat Kings, posting a record of 2-1-1-0. The road team won all four games with no shortage of scoring as the two clubs combined for 28 goals with each team scoring 14 times. Ben MacBeath (6a) led the Hitmen with six points while Julien Maze (3g, 1a), Andrei Molgachev (2g, 2a), Ethan Moore (2g, 2a) and Caine Wilke (1g, 3a) all tallied four points each. Jaxon Jacobson (4g, 3a) was the top performer for Brandon with seven points. Luke Mistelbacher (1g, 5a) was next with six.

2025-26 SERIES RECAP

Nov. 2/25 in BDN: Hitmen 3 Wheat Kings 1...Calgary scored once in every period getting a goal and assist each from Kale Dach and Brandon Gorzynski.

Dec. 19/25 in CGY: Wheat Kings 3 Hitmen 2 OT...Calgary erased a 2-0 deficit before Joby Baumuller scored the winner 2:25 into extra time.

Feb. 6/26 at BDN: Hitmen 5 Wheat Kings 4...The Hitmen erased a 4-1 third period deficit.

Mar. 11/26 in CGY: Wheat Kings 6 Hitmen 4...Brandon broke a 3-3 third period tie scoring twice in the first 11 minutes.

INSIDE THE SERIES

PLAYOFF DATA: This is the eighth time in WHL history but just the first time in 11 seasons the Hitmen and Wheat Kings will square off in a playoff series. Brandon has won four times with Calgary taking three.

1998: BDN 4 CGY 1 Rd3: Wheat Kings were led by Stefan Cherneski with nine points (6g, 3a). Brad Mehalko topped the Hitmen with seven points (1g, 6a).

2005: BDN 4 CGY 3 Rd1: Lance Monych (5g, 2a) & Derek LeBlanc (4g, 3a) led Brandon with seven points each. Ryan Getzlaf led Calgary with nine (3g, 6a).

2007: CGY 4 BDN 2 Rd2: Derek LeBlanc was on the Hitmen this time and led the way with 11 points (5g, 6a). Among his work was a new WHL record for fastest overtime goal, scoring 8 seconds into Game 5. Codey Burki was the top Wheat King with six points (5g, 1a).

2009: CGY 4 BDN 0 Rd3: Kris Foucault was Calgary's top performer with seven points (3g, 4a). Matt Calvert led Brandon with five points (3g, 3a).

2010: CGY 4 BDN 0 Rd3: Brandon Kozun led the way for Calgary with eight points (2g, 6a). Matt Calvert propelled Brandon with five points (4g, 1a).

2012: BDN 4 CGY 1 Rd1: Alessio Bertaglia drove the Wheat Kings attack with six points (3g, 3a). Collin Bowman led Calgary with five points (5a).

2015: BDN 4 CGY 1 Rd3: John Quenneville pillled up 10 points (6g, 4a) to lead Brandon. Adam Tambellini notched five (4g, 1a) for the Hitmen.

PLAYOFF RECORD: Calgary has a lifetime playoff record of 144-120. The Hitmen competed in 48 series prior to this one. They have won 28 and lost 20. Calgary is 34-24 all-time in post-season overtime games.

2025 PLAYOFF REWIND: Last season the Hitmen grabbed Game 2 in their first round series with Saskatoon, skating to a 5-1 win over the visiting Blades to take a 2-0 series lead. Tanner Howe and Brandon Gorzynski led the charge with a goal and an assist each while Ben Kindel chipped in a pair of assists. Calgary outshot Saskatoon 48-23 and received a 22-save performance from goaltender Anders Miller.

NEWS & NOTES:

Last Game: The second-longest game in modern Wheat Kings history ended on a devastating note for Brandon as they fell 1-0 in triple overtime. Filip Ruzicka was sensational with 64 saves on 65 shots, the most saves by a Wheat Kings' goaltender in the internet era. Both teams went 0-for-3 on the power play, both teams hit two posts (one each in regulation and overtime) and Jimmy Egan was stopped on a double-OT penalty shot in what was an almost perfectly evenly matched opening game of a series that, on paper is the closest of any in the WHL playoffs.

Re-Writing The Record Book: Filip Ruzicka's 64 saves in game one against Calgary were the most by a Wheat Kings' goaltender in the internet era (1996-97 to present). Earlier this season, the rookie netminder set another internet era record with 47 saves in a shutout against the Penticton Vees on Friday, February 20.

Rivalry Rekindled: The Wheat Kings meet the Calgary Hitmen in the postseason for the first time since the 2015 Eastern Conference Final, a series Brandon won 4-1. That was the sixth playoff meeting of the two teams in ten seasons, with each team winning three outings. The Wheat Kings also faced the Hitmen twice in the 2010 Memorial Cup, losing in the round robin but winning the semi-final matchup 5-4 in overtime.

Lucky Number 40 Part One: For the first time since the 2018-19 season, the Wheat Kings have two 40-goal scorers thanks to Luke Mistelbacher and Joby Baumuller. Mistelbacher scored his 40th of the season (and picked up his 40th assist as well) in the win over his old team, the Swift Current Broncos, on Saturday, March 7, while Baumuller scored his 40th on Friday, March 20 against Regina. Stello Mattheos and Luka Burzan scored 44 and 40 respectively in 2018-19.

Lucky Number 40 Part Two: With a win over the Regina Pats on Saturday, March 21 the Wheat Kings earned their first 40-win season since 2017-18, when they finished with exactly 40.

Rip Roaring Rookies: With a goal in the win over Calgary on March 11, Chase Surkan became the first Wheat Kings' rookie to score 20 goals in a season since Nate Danielson in 2021-22 (Danielson had played 24 games the year prior). Meanwhile, with a win over the Swift Current Broncos on March 6, Filip Ruzicka became the winningest Wheat Kings' rookie goaltender in over 20 years. The last time a Wheat Kings' rookie goaltender had more wins than Ruzicka's 25 was Tyler Plante in 2004-05 with 34.

Playoff Game 2 vs. Calgary: The Wheat Kings go for the split against the Hitmen in Calgary after a first game that was, as advertised, suffocatingly close. The two teams are by far the closest matched opponents in the first round of the playoffs, with the Wheat Kings finishing just three points behind the Hitmen in the



Eastern Conference standings and the two teams splitting the season series (two wins apiece) and finishing with the exact same number of goals (14) in that season series.

Milestone Watch:

Who's Hot: All Wheat Kings' point streaks came to an end in the shutout loss to Calgary in game one. Filip Ruzicka has stopped 91 of the last 94 shots he has faced.

DID YOU KNOW:

Goon Hockey: When Jordan Gavin was assessed a minor penalty for delay of game on December 5, 2025, it was his first penalty since December 3 of 2022, a stretch of more than three calendar years. Gavin was officially assessed a minor penalty for too many men on the ice on February 25, 2023, but that ought to have been a bench minor and should not have counted toward Gavin's penalty total. Gavin was named the Wheat Kings' Most Sportsmanlike player of 2025-26.

Brandon's 11: The Brandon Wheat Kings played ten games in the month of February, and at no point in any of those games were they healthy enough to field more than 11 forwards (frequently requiring AP call-ups to hit even that number). They finished those 10 games with a 7-3 record, then went 2-1-0 in the first three games of March, during which injuries also reduced them to 11 forwards.

Bleeding Black and Gold: With a win over the Moose Jaw Warriors on December 6, Wheat Kings head coach and GM Marty Murray won his 100th career game as head coach of the Wheat Kings. He is the only active head coach in the WHL to have 100 goals as a player and 100 wins as a coach with the same franchise, and became the first coach to accomplish the feat since Stu Barnes of the Tri City Americans.
