In addition to the duties and objectives listed below, the incumbent will receive the opportunity to gain exposure to different departments and entities within the Niagara IceDogs organization. Primary Responsibilities:

- Assist with content ideation, content creation and execution of campaigns across various social media platforms.

- Assist in creating various marketing collateral, writing press releases, copywriting and copyediting.
- Interact with scouts, corporate partners, executives and players of the Niagara IceDogs Hockey Club, visiting team personnel, media and broadcasting professionals. The candidates will be expected to always act professionally.
- Other duties as assigned.
