Matchup Notes

Tonight marks the third of four meetings between the Oil Kings and Pats this season.

The Oil Kings have taken the first two games of the season series after a 6-1 win in Regina just over a month ago and then a thrilling 4-2 third period come-from-behind win just over three weeks ago at Rogers Place after getting four unanswered goals from John Szabo, Skyler Bruce, Marc Lajoie and Ty Nash in the final 7:37 of the game.

Gavin Hodnett (OG, 5A) leads all Oil Kings skaters in scoring vs. Regina this year with five points in two games while Skyler Bruce (2G, 1A), Ty Nash (2G, 1A) and John Szabo (2G, 1A) each have three points in two games. Kolby Hay is 2-0-0-0 against the Pats with a 1.50gaa and .948sv%.

All-time, the Oil King and Pats have met 62 times in the regular season with the Oil Kings holding a record of 29-29-3-1.

Coming In

The Oil Kings come in off 6-3 loss to the Swift Current Broncos on Friday night, they have now lost four straight games.

In the loss, the Oil Kings got a goal and an assist each from Marc Lajoie and Ty Nash, their fifth and fourth multi-point games respectively this season and Marshall Finnie collected his third goal in his last five games as well.

The Oil Kings went 2-for-4 on the PP, their third multi-PP goal game of the season, and were 3-for-4 on the PK.

The game was also a night of firsts and milestones as Oil Kings prospect Joe Iginla made his WHL debut and recorded his first career WHL point with a first period assist on Finnie's goal. Matthew Gallant collected his first assist and point as an Oil Kings and Carter Kowalyk skated in his 100th career WHL game.

The Pats are coming off a 5-4 shootout loss to the Rebels last night in Red Deer. They were able to salvage a point thanks to late third period goals from Tanner Howe and Borya Valis to erase a 4-2 deficit. The Pats are 2-1-0-2 in their last five games.

EOK Notables

Oil Kings defenceman Marc Lajoie sits 12th in defenceman points (23), second in defenceman goals (10) and first in defenceman PP goals (7) in the WHL.

With his seven power play goals, Lajoie ranks 3rd all-time amongst Oil Kings defencemen for PP goals in a single season, tied with Aaron Irving (7, 2015-16), Cody Corbett (7, 2013-14) and trailing only Conner McDonald (8, 2018-19) and Simon Kubicek (9, 2021-22).

The Oil Kings have killed off 34 of the last 39 penalties they've taken over the past 11 games (87.2%). The Oil Kings PP has gone 15 for its last 62 over the past 15 games (24.2%) and has 17 goals in its last 17 games.

The Oil Kings lead the WHL in attendance (5,593 avg.).

Pats defenceman Parker Berge is tied with Marc Lajoie for second in defenceman goals in the WHL (10) and is sixth in defenceman points in the WHL (34). He has collected nine points (4G, 5A) in his last five games including a hat-trick on December 9 vs. Kelowna.

Pats forward Borya Valis is riding a six-game point streak (4g-4a-8pts).

This and That

Home Sweet Home: All-time, the Oil Kings are **109-99-12-5** at Rogers Place in the regular season and **14-5** in the post-season. Over the past five seasons, the Oil Kings are 96-59-6-3 on home ice (87-58-6-2 at Rogers Place, 9-1-0-1 at the Downtown Community Arena).

Going to Gothenburg: Oil Kings defenceman **Vojtech Port** will get the opportunity to represent his home country of Czechia at the 2024 World Junior Championship in Gothenburg, Sweden later this month as he was named to his country's roster on December 11. Port is the first Oil Kings player to represent Czechia at the tournament since Tomas Vincour (2009, 2010). He also becomes the 13th different Oil King ever to play in the tournament (that does not get cancelled).

Three Kings: On October 25, NHL Central Scouting released their 'Preliminary Players to Watch' list for the 2024 NHL Draft and the list included a trio of Oil Kings skaters:

- **F Adam Jecho** – 'A' Rating (projected 1st rounder)
- **D Parker Alcos** – 'C' Rating (projected 4th-5th rounder)
- **D Rhys Pederson** – 'W' Rating (projected 6th-7th rounder)

Czech Him Out: The Oil Kings used the third overall selection at the 2023 CHL Import Draft to select Zlin, Czechia product **Adam Jecho**. Last season, the lanky forward played U18 hockey in Finland with Tappara Tampere finishing second on his team in scoring with 47 points (21G, 26A) in just 37 games. He has represented his country on a handful of occasions including three times at the Hlinka Gretzky Cup (2021, 2022, 2023) winning a bronze medal in 2023 after serving as an alternate captain and scoring two goals in five games. He also suited up for Czechia at the 2022 World Under-17 Hockey Challenge and the 2023 IIHF U18 World Championship. He is considered a top prospect by several publications for the 2024 NHL Draft.

Family Affair:

- **D Marc Lajoie** is the son of Oil Kings assistant coach Serge Lajoie and is the younger brother of University of Alberta Pandas (USPORTS) **F Isabelle Lajoie**.
- **F Mason Finley** is a second generation WHLer following in not just the footsteps of his father and long-time NHLer **Jeff Finley** (Portland Winterhawks, 1983-87), who played 15 seasons and 708 games with the New York Islanders, Philadelphia Flyers, Winnipeg Jets, Phoenix Coyotes, New York Rangers and St. Louis Blues but also his older brother **Jack Finley**, who wrapped up his WHL career during the 2021-22 season with the Winnipeg ICE and who is now playing for the AHL's Syracuse Crunch. Mason's younger brother, **Max Finley**, plays for the Moose Jaw Warriors.
- **F Marshall Finnie** is the older brother of **Emmitt Finnie** who is in his third season in the WHL with the Kamloops Blazers.
- **F Nathan Pilling** is not just a second generation WHLer, he's a second-generation Oil King. Nathan's grandfather, **Gregg Pilling**, skated with the Oil Kings from 1962 to 1964 and won the 1963 Memorial Cup. Gregg remains heavily involved with the Oil Kings Alumni group.
- **D Blake Fiddler** is following the path of his father Vernon Fiddler, who suited up in 267 career WHL games with the Kelowna Rockets and Medicine Hat Tigers from 1997-2001 before going on to an NHL career that lasted 14 seasons and 877 games split between the Nashville Predators, Phoenix Coyotes, Dallas Stars and New Jersey Devils. Vernon returned to the WHL from 2019-21 as an assistant coach with the Rockets. Blake is also the cousin of former long-time Calgary Hitmen forward and captain **Riley Fiddler-Schultz** (2018-23) and former Everett Silvertips and Seattle Thunderbirds goaltender **Blake Lyda** (2017-20).
- **F Ty Nash** is the son of three-time WHL and Memorial Cup Champion Tyson Nash (Kamloops Blazers – 1992, 1994, 1995). Tyson also suited up in 374 NHL games with the St. Louis Blues and Phoenix Coyotes and now serves as a TV broadcaster for the Coyotes.
- **G Beckett Langkow** is the son of former Portland Winterhawks goaltender **Scott Langkow** (1992-95), who was drafted in the second round of the 1993 NHL Draft by the Winnipeg Jets and went on to have an 18-year pro hockey career which included 20 games in the NHL with the Jets and Phoenix Coyotes. Beckett is also the nephew of former NHLer and WHLer **Daymond Langkow** and the cousin of Vancouver Giants forward **Colton Langkow**.
- **F Joe Iginla**, the Oil Kings 2023 first round draft pick, is the son of **Jarome Iginla**, a Hockey Hall of Famer whose accolades include 1,300 career NHL points (625G, 675A) in 1,554 NHL games, Olympic Gold (2002, 2010), World Hockey Championship Gold (1997), World Cup of Hockey Gold (2004), World Junior Gold (1996) and a two-time Memorial Cup Champion (Kamloops Blazers - 1994, 1995). Joe is also the younger brother of Kelowna Rockets **F Tij Iginla** and Brown University Bears (NCAA) **F Jade Iginla** and the nephew of former University of Saskatchewan Huskies (USPORTS) **F Theresa Iginla**.



This and That

Mr. Worldwide: Oil Kings defenceman **Blake Fiddler** had the opportunity to represent and captain the United States at this past summer's Under-17 Five Nations tournament in Czechia where he put up five points (1G, 4A) in four games helping the team finish second in the tournament with a 3-1-0 record. As a dual citizen, Fiddler just recently represented Canada on the international stage for the first time suiting up in eight games, and scoring one goal, with Canada White at the 2023 World Under-17 Hockey Challenge in P.E.I. where he helped Canada claim its first gold medal at the tournament since 2015.

Making Port in SoCal: On June 29, 2023 in Nashville, Tennessee, Oil Kings defenceman **Vojtech Port** became the 24th modern-era Oil King to be selected in the NHL Draft after the Anaheim Ducks called his name with the 161st overall selection. Port is the first Oil King to ever be drafted by the Anaheim Ducks organization. This past summer, Port attended the Czech National Junior Team's summer development camp, putting himself on the radar to be on their roster for the upcoming 2024 IIHF World Junior Championship.

Historic Hods Hatty: On November 18, 2022 in a game against the Brandon Wheat Kings, Edmonton Oil Kings then rookie forward **Gavin Hodnett** became the youngest Oil King in modern-franchise history record a hat-trick at just 16 years and 223 days old passing the previous holder of the record, Dylan Guenther, who did it at 16 years and 321 days old on February 25, 2020 against the Winnipeg Ice – they are the only two 16-year-olds in the franchise's history to record a hat-trick. On the same night, Hodnett also became the first 16-year-old in modern-franchise history to record five points in a game (3G, 2A).

He Does WUTT?: Oil Kings forward **Treyce Wuttunee** is a multi-sport athlete - during his hockey off-season he competes in the traditional Indigenous sport of rodeo relay, a sport where the bareback riders swap horses and circle the track at top speed.

Percolating Prospects:

- Oil Kings prospect **F Joe Iginla** currently sits first on his team in scoring having put up 25 points (9G, 16A) in 15 games with RHA Kelowna U18 Prep.
- Oil Kings prospect **F Cage Smith** has 15 points (8G, 7A) in 15 games with RHA Kelowna U18 Prep.
- Oil Kings prospect **F Presley Kerner** had a strong finish to his 2022-23 season with U18 OHA Kelowna putting up 26 points in his final 20 games and ended up third on his team in scoring with 29 points (13G, 16A) in 30 games.
- Oil Kings prospect **F Luke Powell** helped his NAX U17 Prep team capture the CSHL U17 Championship last year after notching 41 points (19G, 22A) in 32 regular season games and an additional six points (3G, 3A) in five post-season games.

Gridiron D: Oil Kings prospect **D Noa Ta'amu** is the son of **Ed Ta'amu** who was a standout offensive lineman with at the University of Utah and a 2002 draft pick of the NFL's Minnesota Vikings, spending time on both the Vikings and Houston Texans practice squads. Noa's mom, **Jessica Scott**, was a soccer star at the University of Hawai'i.

Playin' in the Big League: On October 16, 2023 former Oil Kings forward **Justin Sourdif** made his NHL debut with the Florida Panthers in New Jersey against the Devils. LB! Carved on the Cup: Oil Kings alumni goaltender **Laurent Brossoit** became the first modern-era Oil Kings to have his name etched on the Stanley Cup after capturing hockey's Holy Grail with the 2022-23 Vegas Golden Knights. During the post-season, LB went 5-2 with a 3.18gaa and .898sv% before suffering a lower-body injury that would hold him out for the remainder of the playoffs. This past offseason, he signed a one-year contract with the Winnipeg Jets.

TRISTORY: Oil Kings alumni goaltender **Tristan Jarry** became the second-ever goaltender (Chris Mason) in history to record a goal in both the AHL and NHL after the two-time NHL All-Star found the back of the net on November 30 vs. the Tampa Lightning. He is the 14th goalie in NHL history to achieve the feat and the ninth to score a goal by actually shooting it into the net. He is also the first-ever Pittsburgh Penguins goaltender to score a goal.

Opponent: The Edmonton Oil Kings are coming off a 10-54-4-0 season with 24 points, finishing last in the WHL...their 10 victories were the lowest in franchise history...the comes after winning their third WHL Championship since 2011, going 50-14-3-1 in the 2021-22 season...the Oil Kings have been to the WHL Final four times in their history (2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14, 2022-23), with their only loss coming in 2012-13.

It's the third of four meetings this season between these two clubs...last season, the Pats went 3-1 against the Oil Kings, outscoring them 22-12...the Pats went 1-3 in the 2021-22 season series against Edmonton, and were outscored 23-to-15...the Pats are 6-11-2 over the last 19 meetings against the Oil Kings since the 2018-19 season...they've dropped their last three games against Edmonton.

The Regina Pats finished the 2022-23 regular season with a 34-30-3-1 record and 72 points, sixth in the Eastern Conf. and 11th in the WHL, making the playoffs for the first time since 2018...they ranked fifth in goals for, scoring 262 goals, averaging 3.85 goals per-game...the power play finished seventh at 26.7% while their penalty kill saw an improvement, going from 71.9% in 2021-22 to 77.0% in 2022-23.

Pats defenceman Parker Berge scored his first career hat-trick on Saturday, December 9 vs. Kelowna, becoming the first Pats defenceman to score a hat-trick since Josh Mahura on December 8, 2017 vs. Kelowna.

Ewan Huet is currently with Switzerland's National World Junior team as they prepare for the 2024 World Juniors in Sweden...Huet was one of three goaltenders selected to the roster and one of four CHL players selected to represent Switzerland's roster.

- The Regina Pats won their fourth straight Teddy Bear Toss game on Saturday, December 2 vs. Swift Current (SOW, 6-5)...Sam Oremba became the fifth Regina born player to score the marker...the Pats scored the Teddy Toss goal in the first period for a 10th straight occasion.
- November 11, Regina Pats 2007-born forward Cole Temple won gold with Team Canada White at the U17 World Hockey Challenge, as they defeated U.S.A 2-1 in overtime...Temple finished the tournament with six points in eight games (2G-4A).
- October 25, NHL Central Scouting announced it's 'Preliminary Players to Watch' List for the 2024 NHL Draft, with Pats captain Tanner Howe, and twins Jaxsin and Corbin Vaughan cracking the list...Howe is an 'A' level prospect while the Vaughan's are 'W' level prospects...the 'A' category indicates players projected to be first-round candidates while the 'W' rating, which indicates players projected to be sixth- or seventh-round candidates.
- October 23, Hockey Canada announced that Regina Pats forward Cole Temple will be representing Team Canada White at the 2023 World Under-17 Hockey Challenge in Charlottetown and Summerside, P.E.I from November 2-11...he was one of 14 2007-born WHL players selected to represent Canada.
- October 22, Pats prospects Zach Lansard, Tegan Kurtz & Carter Haney took home a gold medal at the 2023 WHL Cup with Team Manitoba...meanwhile, Pats prospect Cohen Klassen and Team Saskatchewan won bronze.
- October 10, Regina Pats alumnus Connor Bedard made his NHL debut against the Pittsburgh Penguins, adding an assist in a 4-2 victory in their season opener...Bedard became the 165th former Pats player to reach the NHL.
- October 4, the Regina Pats defeated the Medicine Hat Tigers 4-2 to capture franchise victory #2500.
- September 21, the Regina Pats announced their 2023-24 leadership group, naming Tanner Howe the 82nd captain in franchise history, with Parker Berge and Braxton Whitehead serving as alternate captains...Howe became the second youngest captain in team history (17 years old, 9 months, 24 days), joining Connor Bedard and Barret Jackman as the only players to be named captain of the Pats while being 17-years-old.
- August 8, former Pats Director of Hockey Ops Landon Watson accepted a role with the Arizona Coyotes as their Manager, Hockey Operations...with Watson leaving the organization after seven seasons, the Pats hired former University of Regina Cougars captain Tristan Frei as the clubs Manager, Hockey Operations.
- July 13, Brad Herauf was named the 43rd Head Coach in franchise history after spending the last eight seasons with the Pats as their assistant coach.
- July 10, former Pats as GM/HC John Paddock announced his retirement after nine seasons with the club and 39 years in hockey management & coaching...the Pats also announced Alan Millar as the new VP, Hockey Ops & GM...Paddock finishes his tenure as Pats coach second in franchise wins (209) and third in games coached (378).
- June 28, the Chicago Blackhawks selected Connor Bedard with the first overall pick of the 2023 NHL Draft...Bedard became the third ever Regina Pats player to be selected first overall and the first since 1980, joining Greg Joly and Doug Wickenheiser...he was also the first Western Hockey League player to be drafted first overall since Ryan Nugent-Hopkins was drafted by the Edmonton Oilers with the first pick of the 2011 NHL Draft. Before him, it was Chris Phillips taken first overall in 1996 by the Ottawa Senators.
- June 3, Connor Bedard took home the CHL's Top Prospect Award presented by Kubota Canada, Top Scorer Award, and David Branch Player of the Year Award presented by Kia Canada — marking the first time in CHL history that a skater has won all three of these awards in the same season since the introduction of the CHL's Top Scorer award in 1994.
- Bedard also became the first Regina Pats player to win the CHL Player of the Year Award since Jordan Eberle (2009-10), while just the fourth Pats player to win this award, joining Doug Wickenheiser (1979-80), Ed Staniowski (1974-75) and Eberle. He also became the first Pats player to win the CHL Top Scorer Award since Sam Steel (2016-17) as well as the first Pats player all-time to earn the CHL Top Draft Prospect.
