SCOUTING REPORT

REGINA PATS



The Regina Pats head into Edmonton at the tail end of a stretch of eight games away from home including their five-game trip to the B.C. division.

Through six games in this stretch Regina is 1-5-0-0. Their win came against the Vancouver Giants on Wednesday, December 4, and prior to their final stop in Edmonton, the Pats were in Prince George on Friday for a meeting with the Cougars. Regina is 7-16-2-2 on the season, which has them at 18 points.

Tonight will mark the second of four meetings between the Oil Kings and Pats, with Regina taking the first meeting back on October 5 in Regina, in a shootout by a 3-2 score. Offensively this season, Tye Spencer leads the way for Regina with 17 points (8G, 9A).

PLAYER TO WATCH

5 JOHN BABCOCK

Defenceman John Babcock has made his way to Regina for his final WHL season, bringing plenty of experience to a young Pats blueline.

The 20-year-old out of North Vancouver, B.C. was originally drafted by the Kelowna Rockets in the fifth-round of the 2019 WHL Prospects Draft and played 160 games with the Rockets before being moved to Saskatoon midway through the 2023/2024 season where he and the Blades made a run to game seven of the Eastern Conference Final.

Now, Babcock is off to a solid start with the Regina Pats, earning 13 assists through 27 games, which puts him on pace to exceed his career-highs in assists [20] and points [23]. He's also sporting an Even plus-minus at this point of the season.
