SAWCHYN IS SUPERB

**LUKAS SAWCHYN'S FIRST WHL
SEASON OFF TO SOLID START**

On September 19, 2024 the Edmonton Oil Kings signed 2007-born forward Lukas Sawchyn to a WHL Scholarship & Development Agreement, and the Grande Prairie, Alta. product has produced at a high level in his first season in the WHL.

Sawchyn was originally drafted in the 2022 U.S. Prospects Draft by Seattle, but was then traded from the Thunderbirds to Edmonton with his brother Gracyn in December of 2023 and elected to sign with the club this season after spending the 2023/2024 season with the Chicago Steel of the USHL.

In just his second game with the Oil Kings, Sawchyn scored his first WHL goal against Medicine Hat and has since tallied 19 points in 28 games, including 15 assists and four goals. His most recent goal, on December 8 against Regina was his first Game Winning Goal as he finished off a feed from his brother Gracyn in overtime to give the Oil Kings the 3-2 win.

Sawchyn's 19 points have him tied for ninth among WHL Rookies, and his 15 assists are tied for fourth among first-year players.



SCOUTING REPORT

SWIFT CURRENT BRONCOS



The Swift Current Broncos make their first visit of the season to Rogers Place tonight with the Eastern Conference standings extremely close as the Holiday Break approaches.

The Broncos are 16-11-0-1 and are third in the conference with 33 points, while the Oil Kings are just three points back in the eighth and final playoff spot with a 14-12-1-1 record, which means tonight's two points are that much more valuable.

Swift Current begins three games through the Central Division tonight as they'll also head to Calgary and Red Deer before the break. The Broncos are led offensively by Luke Mistelbacher who has 45 points (17G, 28A) in 28 games so far this season.

PLAYER TO WATCH

25 CLARKE CASWELL

Broncos forward Clarke Caswell is into his third WHL season and is well on his way to exceeding his production from a season ago.

The Brandon, Man. product was named the Broncos new captain in September just a few months after he was selected in the fifth-round, 141st overall at the NHL Draft by the Seattle Kraken.

After a 77 point season in 2023/2024, Caswell is already more than halfway to that point in 26 games with 41 points (11G, 30A) in 26 games. His 1.58 points-per-game lead the Broncos and his 30 assists has him fourth in the WHL. Caswell has played in 160 games in the WHL, and has tallied nearly 150 points after being the sixth-overall selection in the 2021 WHL Prospects Draft.
