IGINLA IS HISTORIC

JOE IGINLA PUTS NAME IN OIL KINGS RECORD BOOKS

Oil Kings Forward Joe Iginla has etched his name in the Oil Kings record books after a historic game on December 29 at Rogers Place against the Red Deer Rebels.

The rookie forward earned his first career hat-trick in the Oil Kings 8-2 win as Iginla scored a powerplay goal late in the first to make it 5-2 and then added another marker in the second before securing the hat-trick with less than two minutes to play in the third.

With that hat-trick, Iginla becomes the youngest Oil King to record a hat-trick at 16 years and 139 days old, passing current Captain Gavin Hodnett who was 16 years and 223 days old at the time of his hat-trick in November of 2022. Iginla is also just the third Oil Kings 16-year-old to record a hat-trick, joining Hodnett and Dylan Guenther.

The Lake Country, B.C. product and former 12th overall selection in the 2023 WHL Draft is now up to nine points (7G, 2A) in 27 games this season.

SCOUTING REPORT

LETHBRIDGE HURRICANES

The Edmonton Oil Kings and Lethbridge Hurricanes play the final of a three-games in three-night stretch today at Rogers Place.

Heading into the weekend, the Hurricanes are 19-12-1-1, good for 40 points, which is just two points ahead of the Oil Kings, who are 18-14-1-1 at 38 points. Lethbridge has won seven of their last 10 games heading into the weekend, while the Oil Kings have won 10 of their last 14 games.

Lethbridge is led offensively by Brayden Edwards who has 40 points [16G, 24A] in 30 games so far this season.

Today marks just the fourth of eight meeting of the season between the Oil Kings and the Hurricanes. The two clubs will ultimately meet seven times in the 2025 portion of the season, including four times in January. Lethbridge won the first meeting of the season back on opening night on September 20 in Lethbridge.

PLAYER TO WATCH

19 BRAYDEN EDWARDS

Hurricanes 20-year-old Forward Brayden Edwards has been a driver of offense for the Lethbridge Hurricanes this season.

Out of Abbotsford, B.C., Edwards currently has 16 goals on the season, the second most on the Hurricanes, and his 24 assists lead the team along with his 40 points.

Originally a sixth-round selection of the then-Kootenay Ice in the 2019 WHL Prospects Draft, Edwards has spent the majority of his career with the Hurricanes and has played in more than 200 with Lethbridge. Across his WHL career, Edwards has 67 goals and 165 points, including a career high 70 points with 31 goals in 2023/2024.
