NOA TA'AMU GETTING MORE COMFORTABLE IN FIRST WHL SEASON


Oil Kings Defenceman Noa Ta'Amu is continuing to grow on the Edmonton blue line in his 16-year-old season.

The San Diego, California, U.S.A product was originally the third overall selection in the 2023 WHL U.S. Prospects Draft and has now played in 20 games in his first season in the WHL. Ta'Amu scored his first career goal in Seattle on November 1 as the Oil Kings defeated Seattle 5-4 in a shootout.

Ta'Amu has also added an assist this season to go along with a +4 rating, eight penalty minutes, and 12 shots on goal.

Prior to joining the Oil Kings full-time, Ta'Amu played his lone U18 season at the Okanagan Hockey Academy, playing 24 games and earning 17 points that season.

Ta'Amu, along with fellow defenceman Josh Lee, forward Cage Smith, and goalie Parker Snell are just a few of the 2008-born players that are showing lots of promise for the Edmonton Oil Kings this season and moving forward.

SCOUTING REPORT

SASKATOON BLADES



The Edmonton Oil Kings and Saskatoon Blades play their third of four meetings against each other this season tonight at Rogers Place.

Saskatoon has won both previous meetings so far, but the Oil Kings are playing some of their best hockey this season, having gone 12-4-0-1 in their last 17 games. Overall, Edmonton is 20-14-1-2 on the year, while the Blades, heading into a three-game stretch in Alberta, are 21-12-2-2, which has them tied for first place in the conference. The Blades powerplay is currently sitting second best in the Eastern Conference, and third overall in the WHL at 28.5%.

Saskatoon is led offensively by Ben Riche who has 53 points (23G, 30A) in 36 games.

The Oil Kings and Blades will meet one more time this regular season on March 2 in Saskatoon.



PLAYER TO WATCH

25 COOPER WILLIAMS

Blades rookie forward Cooper Williams is quickly finding his groove in the WHL.

Originally a second-round pick, 41st overall by the Blades in the 2023 WHL Prospects Draft, Williams is already fifth on the Blades in scoring this season, and first among Blades rookies. In 37 games, Williams has eight goals and 17 assists for 25 points.

He ranks inside the Top-10 in WHL Rookie Points, and Assists, and is tied for 10th in rookie goals.

Williams, out of Calgary, Alta., is not eligible until the 2026 NHL Entry Draft.
