HODNETT'S HOT STREAK

GAVIN HODNETT RED HOT TO START FEBRUARY

Oil Kings Captain Gavin Hodnett has been on fire to start the month of February for the Oil Kings.

The Winnipeg, Man. product has three goals and four assists for seven points in his last three games, highlighted by a hat-trick on February 7 in Calgary against the Hitmen. Hodnett scored all three goals in the game that night, including two in the final two minutes with the goalie pulled. The three-goal performance was Hodnett's second career WHL hat-trick and first since his 16-year-old season.

Through 51 games this season, Hodnett has 23 goals, matching a career-high that he set last season, along with 31 assists for 54 points. The 18-year-old is tied for the Oil Kings lead in goals, and is second on the team in assists and points. Hodnett also has 11 powerplay goals, which are tied for 11th in the WHL.

Hodnett is now nearing 180 games in the WHL and reached a milestone of 100 assists on December 7 in Medicine Hat. His 111 assists are now ninth most in Oil Kings Modern Franchise History. Hodnett also sits inside the Top-10 of the Oil Kings all-time lists in Powerplay Assists (6th) and Powerplay Points (5th) with 48 and 70 respectively.

SCOUTING REPORT LETHBRIDGE HURRICANES

The Edmonton Oil Kings and Lethbridge Hurricanes play the seventh of eight meetings tonight at Rogers Place.

So far this season, the Oil Kings and Hurricanes have split the season series, three games each. Edmonton has scored 19 goals, while Lethbridge has scored 14 through the six games to this point. Edmonton is led offensively in the series by Landon Hanson who has five goals and two assists for seven points in six games. Lethbridge is led in the series by Brayden Yager who has five points in four games.

Heading into the weekend, the Hurricanes are 33-16-2-1, while the Oil Kings are 28-19-2-2. The two teams sit fourth and fifth in the WHL's Eastern Conference respectively.

PLAYER TO WATCH 28 LEO BRAILLARD

Hurricanes import forward Leo Brailard having a career year in his second season in the WHL.

Formerly an import draft pick of the Shawinigan Cataractes in the Quebec Maritimes Junior Hockey League, Brailard has since found a home in Lethbridge. The 19-year-old forward has scored 21 goals this season, tied for third on the Hurricanes, and has 14 assists for 35 points, surpassing last season's total of 34 points.

Brailard, a Swiss national, has represented Team Switzerland at the World Junior Hockey Championships the last two seasons. In 10 games across the two tournaments, Brailard has four goals and five points.

Out of La Chaux-de-Fonds, Switzerland, Brailard has played 88 games for Lethbridge, scoring 34 times and adding 35 assists across the last two seasons.
