TSAKUMIS FITTING RIGHT IN

NIKO TSAKUMIS ADDS ANOTHER ELEMENT TO OIL KINGS BLUE LINE

The Edmonton Oil Kings acquired 2005-born defenceman Niko Tsakumis on December 28 from the Kamloops Blazers, adding a veteran presence to their blue line.

Tsakumis made his Oil Kings debut on January 11 against Medicine Hat and has since played 15 games in an Oil Kings uniform. The Richmond, B.C. product recorded his first two assists as an Oil King on February 1 in Edmonton's 2-0 win in Lethbridge over the Hurricanes. Since then, Tsakumis has recorded three more assists in the next six games. He's up to 11 assists on the season, split between Edmonton and Kamloops.

Tsakumis is a veteran of 145 games in the WHL split between the Seattle Thunderbirds, Everett Silvertips, Blazers, and now Oil Kings. He also played in nine playoff games with the Silvertips during their 2024 playoffs where they made the second round.

The 19-year-old is also a career +21 rating, including a +1 rating so far with the Oil Kings this season.

SCOUTING REPORT MEDICINE HAT TIGERS

The Edmonton Oil Kings and Medicine Hat Tigers finish off their season series tonight at Rogers Place.

Heading into this weekend's home and home set, each team had won three contests, and each team was 1-2-0-0 on home ice. The team's last met on January 11 in Edmonton with the Tigers taking a 6-1 decision. Through six games in the series, Gavin Hodnett and Lukas Sawchyn are leading the Oil Kings with six points each, while Medicine Hat is led by Gavin McKenna who has seven points in the series.

Medicine Hat became the first team in the Eastern Conference to clinch a playoff spot on Family Day Monday. They're 37-16-3-1 heading into the weekend's action.

Edmonton is 30-20-2-2 heading into the weekend, good for 64 points.

PLAYER TO WATCH

18 JONAS WOO

Medicine Hat Tigers Defenceman Jonas Woo is making his mark with the Tigers in his first-year of NHL Draft eligibility.

The late-2006-born defenceman out of Winnipeg, Man., Woo has played in 55 games for the Tigers this season and has already smashed his previous career highs in goals, assists, and points. He's scored 11 times and added 30 assists for 41 points, which is sixth on the Tigers.

Woo was originally drafted 18th overall by the Winnipeg Jets organization and played parts of three seasons with Winnipeg and then Wenatchee when the franchise moved prior to the 2023/2024 season.

Woo recently reached the 200 game plateau. He's ranked 147th among North American Skaters in NHL Central Scouting's Mid-Term Rankings.
