GRACYN RETURNS WITH A BANG

GRACYN SAWCHYN ON LENGTHY POINT STEAK SINCE RETURN FROM INJURY

Oil Kings Assistant Captain Gracyn Sawchyn has certainly been a welcome sight since returning from a ten-game absence with injury.

The 19-year-old forward re-entered the lineup on February 15 with friends and family in town and he would go on to earn an assist in that game against Lethbridge before going on a eight game point streak that is still currently alive. During the streak, Sawchyn has five goals and seven assists for 12 points. Three of the goals have also come on the powerplay, and Sawchyn is also winning 57.6% of his faceoffs during this stretch.

Overall on the season, Sawchyn leads the Oil Kings in goals, assists, and points. He's tallied 28 goals and 43 assists for 71 points and is +19. His 20 powerplay assists are also 11th in the WHL and his six game winning goals are tied for eighth in the league as well.

The Florida Panther signed prospect is now at 159 career games and is approaching the 200 point plateau for his career.

SCOUTING REPORT BRANDON WHEAT KINGS

The Edmonton Oil Kings and Brandon Wheat Kings meet for the fourth and final time this season at Rogers Place tonight.

The Oil Kings are 0-3-0-0 so far this season against Brandon and the two most recently met back on February 26 in Brandon. The Wheat Kings head into tonight's game on the second-half of a back-to-back as they played last night in Red Deer and are in a four game swing through the Central Division.

The Wheat Kings are 32-19-4-3 heading into this road trip and are one point ahead of the Oil Kings who are 33-23-2-2 after a 2-2-0-0 East Division road trip.

In the season series, Edmonton is led offensively by Gracyn Sawchyn and Gavin Hodnett who each have two points. Brandon is led by Jaxon Jacobson who has five points in three games.

PLAYER TO WATCH: 11 JORDAN GAVIN

Wheat Kings forward Jordan Gavin has found a nice home in Brandon since being acquired from the Tri-City Americans in January.

The late-2006-born forward is in his first year of eligibility for the NHL Draft and has tallied 49 points in 58 games split between the two teams. With Brandon, Gavin has 19 points in 23 games.

Originally the second-overall selection in the 2021 WHL Prospects Draft, Gavin has played in nearly 200 games already in his career and has 173 points. On top of that, Gavin has also avoided the penalty box, only tallying four penalty minutes across his entire career.

Gavin is currently ranked 123rd among North American Skaters in NHL Central Scouting's Mid-Term Rankings.
