DEAN STARTS WELL IN WHL

DYLAN DEAN ADJUSTING TO WHL

Edmonton Oil Kings rookie forward Dylan Dean is off to an excellent start in the Western Hockey League.

The 17-year-old earned his spot on the roster through a solid training camp and has opened his WHL career with six goals and four assists for nine points in 14 games. He's also had three games with two or more points, including his first career three point game on Wednesday in Lethbridge. It was also his first career two-goal game.

Out of Maple Grove, Minnesota, U.S.A., Dean was the 23rd overall selection in the 2023 WHL U.S. Prospects Draft and signed with the Oil Kings during the summer of 2025. He previously spent time for the last two seasons with the Long Island Gulls at the 15U and 16U levels, producing offence to the tune of 121 points in 95 games across both levels.

Dean is also rated as a 'W' prospect by NHL Central Scouting on their Preliminary Players to Watch List ahead of the 2026 NHL Draft, which projects him as a possible sixth or seventh round pick.
