HOW ABOUT HANSON!

EDMONTON OIL KINGS FORWARD LANDON HANSON HAS BEEN PLAYING SOME EXCELLENT HOCKEY FOR THE OIL KINGS IN NOVEMBER AS THE TEAM HAS SPORDED AN 8-2-0-0 RECORD THROUGH 10 GAMES IN THE MONTH.

DURING THAT TIME, HANSON HAS SEVEN GOALS, TIED FOR THE TEAM LEAD TO GO ALONG WITH FIVE ASSISTS FOR 12 POINTS. HE IS ONE OF SIX OIL KINGS WITH 10 OR MORE POINTS IN THE MONTH. AS PART OF THAT STRETCH, HANSON ALSO HAD A SEVEN-GAME POINT STREAK STRETCHING FROM OCTOBER 29 TO NOVEMBER 14.

THROUGH 26 GAMES THIS SEASON, THE GRANDE PRAIRIE, ALTA. PRODUCT HAS SCORED 10 GOALS TO GO ALONG WITH 10 ASSISTS AND A +11 RATING. HE'S ALSO GOT ONE SHORTHANDED GOAL, WHICH IS THE FOURTH IN HIS CAREER. THAT NUMBER HAS HIM TIED FOR SEVENTH ON THE OIL KINGS ALL-TIME LIST, AND JUST TWO AWAY FROM TYING THE ALL-TIME LEAD.

ORIGINALLY SIGNED AS AN UNRAFTED FREE AGENT BY THE OIL KINGS, HANSON HAS PLAYED MORE THAN 170 GAMES WITH THE OIL KINGS IN HIS CAREER, AND HAS 63 POINTS.

ROLL BACK THE CLOCK TO 2024, AND HANSON ALSO NOTCHED A MASSIVE GOAL FOR THE OIL KINGS, THE TEDDY BEAR TOSS GOAL AGAINST THE EVERETT SILVERTIPS ON DECEMBER 1. WITH THE BIGGEST GAME OF THE YEAR COMING UP IN EXACTLY ONE WEEK, COULD HANSON BECOME THE FIRST EVER TWO-TIME TEDDY BEAR TOSS GOAL SCORER IN OIL KINGS HISTORY?
