TA'AMU CONTINUING TO DEVELOP IN SECOND WHL SEASON

Edmonton Oil Kings Defenceman Noa Ta'amu continues to take steps in his development in the WHL.

The 6'2", 237lbs defender has been an imposing presence on the Oil Kings blue line as he plays his second season in the WHL. In 25 games this season, Ta'amu has three assists, and is sporting a +7 rating. He is on pace to exceed his assist total from last season, and his game has continued to grow outside of the box score. Ta'amu has been a physical presence for the Oil Kings and doesn't let opponents off easy in tough areas of the ice.

Through 68 career games, the San Diego, California product has 9 points and is a +11 for the Oil Kings after he was drafted third overall in the 2023 U.S. Prospects Draft.

Meanwhile, this past summer, Ta'amu was able to represent Team U.S.A at the Hlinka Gretzky Cup in Czechia and Slovakia. Ta'amu and Team U.S.A were able to win gold at the event with Ta'amu earning one assist in five games and holding a +4 rating.

Ta'amu is also listed as a 'W' skater by NHL Central Scouting ahead of the 2026 NHL Draft.

The name "Red Deer" comes from European settlers who mistook the local elk for "red deer" a species found in Europe.
