Last Night: The Edmonton Oil Kings have now won seven straight games after a 3-1 win over the Saskatoon Blades on Friday night at the Sasktel Centre. All three Oil Kings goals came on the powerplay with Max Curran scoring twice and Blake Fiddler scoring once. The powerplay was 3-for-6 in the game and the penalty kill was 6-for-6. Parker Snell stopped 19 shots in the win.

Terrific Top Line: The Edmonton Oil Kings top line of Miroslav Holinka (9G, 7A), Lukas Sawchyn (5G, 9A), and Gavin Hodnett (3G, 12A) has combined for 45 points in the seven games since the Holiday break. The Oil Kings have won seven in a row and have outscored their opponents 34-14.

World Juniors: A pair of Edmonton Oil Kings took home some hardware at the World Junior Hockey Championships. Forward Max Curran helped Team Czechia win silver at the event while scoring one goal and adding four assists for five points in seven games. Defenceman Ethan MacKenzie helped Team Canada win bronze at the event while scoring one goal and adding four assists for five points in seven games.

The Opponent: Tonight marks the third of four meetings between the Oil Kings and Prince Albert Raiders. The Oil Kings hold a 1-0-1-0 record with both teams scoring six goals and both games going into overtime. The road team has also won both games of the series. Miroslav Holinka and Lukas Sawchyn each have three points in the season series.

This and That

Trades: The Edmonton Oil Kings have announced three trades. On January 5, the Oil Kings acquired 2007-born forward Aaron Obobaifo from the Vancouver Giants, in exchange for 2008-born forward Joe Iginla. Conditional Picks were also swapped. Then on January 6, the Oil Kings acquired 2005-born defenceman Carter Sotheran from the Portland Winterhawks in exchange for 2005-born defenceman Niko Tsakumis and draft picks. The Oil Kings then traded 2006-born defenceman Parker Alcos to the Kelowna Rockets in exchange for draft picks.

First Half Recap: Through 34 games this season, the Edmonton Oil Kings earned a 23-7-3-1 record, earning 50 points in the standings. The Oil Kings scored 144 goals (4.24/game) and allowed 100 goals (2.94/game). The team earned a 19.4% powerplay and a penalty kill of 81.0%, while scoring six shorthanded goals. Miroslav Holinka led the team in goals (20), assists (28) and points (48) in the first half.

Draft Season!: NHL Central Scouting released their Preliminary Players to Watch list on Monday, October 20 ahead of the 2026 NHL Entry Draft. 7 Oil Kings were named in the list with Joe Iginla, Andrew O'Neill, Parker Snell, and Noa Ta'amu being listed as 'C' prospects which are projected 4th and 5th Round picks. Meanwhile, Dylan Dean, Kanjyu Gojsic, and Lukas Sawchyn are 'W' prospects which project to be 6th or 7th round draft picks.

Few Like Fuder: The Edmonton Oil Kings announced on December 27 that they have acquired 2006-born forward Jaxon Fuder from the Red Deer Rebels, in exchange for 2007-born forward Poul Andersen, 2009-born forward Boris Sigachev, and 2009-born forward Brock Stevenson. Fuder, a signed prospect of the Dallas Stars, has 50 points in 73 WHL games.

Zemlak Acquired: The Edmonton Oil Kings announced on December 27 that they have acquired 2005-born defenceman Austin Zemlak from the Tri-City Americans in exchange for a second-round draft pick, and a conditional fifth-round draft pick. Zemlak, out of Fort McMurray, AB, has spent the beginning of this season with Arizona State University (NCAA DI). Prior to that, Zemlak played over 200 WHL games with the Americans, and the Victoria Royals, tallying 15 goals and 43 assists for 58 points.

20 Win Club: The Edmonton Oil Kings reached 20 wins on the season on Sunday, November 30 with their win over the Saskatoon Blades. It took the team 28 games to reach the 20-win plateau, making them the fastest team in modern Oil Kings franchise history, passing the 2021/2022 team that needed 29 games to get there.

Going Streaking: The Edmonton Oil Kings nine-game winning streak that spanned from October 29 to November 18 is the longest since the team won 14 games in a row during the 2021/2022 Season. The streak is tied for the seventh Longest in Oil Kings franchise history.

Wearing the Maple Leaf: A pair of Edmonton Oil Kings represented Canada at the World Under-17 Hockey Challenge in Nova Scotia in early November. Forward Kayden Stroeder and Assistant Coach Kyle Chipchura are back with Silver medals after representing Team Canada White at the event. Stroeder had 6 points (1G, 5A) in five games at the event.

Fresh Face: The Edmonton Oil Kings made a trade on Sunday, November 9, acquiring 2008-born forward Kanjyu Gojsic from the Kelowna Rockets along with a 2029 sixth-round draft pick in exchange for a 2026 third-round pick and a 2029 fourth-round pick. Gojsic has played 69 career games in the WHL and has 20 points.

Players of the Week: The Oil Kings had two players named in the November 3 WHL Players of the Week Awards. Max Curran was named WHL Player of the Week, while Dylan Dean was named Rookie of the Week. Curran had 10 points (3G, 7A) in three games including the 12th five-plus-point night in Oil Kings history on Sunday, November 2, while Dean had six points (4G, 2A) in three games.

WHL Cup: Three Edmonton Oil Kings prospects are headed home with hardware after the 2025 WHL Cup in Red Deer. Second-round pick Cole Landreville helped Team Manitoba win gold after defeating Defenders Holden Wouters and Chris Kokkoris and Team B.C. in the championship game. Landreville finished tied for fourth in tournament scoring with seven points (2G, 5A), while Wouters (3A) and Kokkoris (1G, 2A) each had three points.

New Coach, No Problem: Jason Smith is off to a hot start as the Edmonton Oil Kings new head coach. His 8-2-0-0 record to begin the season is the best 10-game start to an Oil Kings season in a coach's first season with the club.

Super Snell: Oil Kings rookie netminder Parker Snell has put himself into the Oil Kings record books once again. Already the youngest Oil King to earn a shutout, Snell also holds the longest streak in Oil Kings modern franchise history for consecutive wins to start their tenure with the Oil Kings (7 Wins).

High-Five: On Monday, October 13, Oil Kings forward Miroslav Holinka notched five points in a the Oil Kings 6-2 win over Lethbridge. His two goal, three assist night was just the 11th five-plus point night in Edmonton Oil Kings modern franchise history and first since November 18, 2022 when current Captain Gavin Hodnett had five points against the Brandon Wheat Kings. Forward Max Curran became the 12th Oil Kings with a five-point night on November 2 against the Swift Current Broncos.

Behind the Bench: On July 31, 2024, the Edmonton Oil Kings announced Jason Smith as the 6th Head Coach in team history. The former Edmonton Oilers Captain most recently spent time with the Lehigh Valley Phantoms of the AHL and has previous Head Coaching experience in Kelowna with the Rockets between 2016 and 2019, earning a 94-54-12 record. On Saturday, October 11, Smith recorded his 100th career WHL win as a Head Coach. He now holds a record of 101-56-12 in his career.

Stellar Snell: Oil Kings netminder Parker Snell was named the WHL's Goaltender of the Week on Monday for his performances over the Oil Kings East Division swing from October 1-4. Snell was 2-0-0-0 while stopping 46 of 49 shots and earning his second career WHL shutout on October 4 in Brandon with a 26 save performance.

Leadership Group: On Friday, September 26, the Edmonton Oil Kings announced the remainder of their leadership group for the 2025/2026 season. With Gavin Hodnett returning as Captain for a second season, the 19-year-old is joined by Adam Jecho and Ethan MacKenzie on the road, and Blake Fiddler and Rhys Pederson at home wearing 'A's. The five players have a combined more than 700 WHL games to their credit.

Kraken Up: Oil Kings Defenceman Blake Fiddler was drafted by the Seattle Kraken in the second round, 36th overall of the 2025 NHL Entry Draft this summer. He is the highest drafted Oil Kings since 2021.

Golden Boys: Two Edmonton Oil Kings are back with the club with gold medals earned over the summer. Forward Lukas Sawchyn won gold with Team Canada at the World Under-18 Championships in the spring. Meanwhile, Noa Ta'amu helped Team U.S.A. win gold at the Hlinka Gretzky Cup in Czechia and Slovakia.

Stroeder Scoring: On Friday, December 27, 2024, Oil Kings forward Kayden Stroeder scored his first two career WHL Goals and added an assist. He is the first Oil Kings 15-year-old to earn three points in a game. He's also the youngest player in Oil Kings modern history to score a Game Winning Goal at 15 years, 9 months, and 26 days. The Lanigan, Sask. product also became just the third 15-year-old to score multiple goals in one game in Oil Kings history, joining Dylan Guenther (12/16/18) and Joe Iginla (2/19/24). Meanwhile, Stroeder's 8 points in his 15-year-old season were the most by a player of that age in franchise history.

I Snell a Shutout: The Edmonton Oil Kings decided to start 2008-born netminder Parker Snell on November 30, 2024 at home against Prince George. In his first career WHL start, the St. Albert, AB product earned a 29 save shutout for his first WHL win. He becomes just the second Oil Kings netminder in team history to earn a shutout in his WHL debut, joining Sebastien Cossa in October of 2019. He is also the youngest Oil Kings netminder to record a shutout at 16 years, 7 months, and 9 days.

Family Affair:
