ADAM JECHO BECOMING LEADER WITH OIL KINGS

Edmonton Oil Kings forward Adam Jecho is now in his third season in the WHL since coming over from Czechia.

Once the third-overall selection in the 2023 CHL Import Draft, Jecho, out of Zlin, Czechia, has now played over 140 games with the Oil Kings organization. This season, Jecho has six goals and 17 assists for 23 points in 31 games. On top of his offensive production as a player, Jecho has been recognized for his leadership this season as one of the Oil Kings assistant captains, wearing the 'A' during home games this year.

In his career, Jecho has scored 54 goals and added 68 assists for 122 points. He's also had 10 game winning goals and 17 powerplay markers across his three seasons with the club. He ranks at the top of the Oil Kings all-time lists for an import player in goals, assists, and points, and is third in games played by an import player.

He's also added three points in seven playoff games for the Oil Kings.

In 2024, Jecho was made a third-round pick, 95th overall by the St. Louis Blues in the NHL Entry Draft and then signed his entry level deal in March of 2025. He also helped Team Czechia win bronze at the 2025 World Junior Hockey Championships.
