SUPER SOTHERAN

CARTER SOTHERAN ADDS NAME TO OIL KINGS HISTORY BOOK

Edmonton Oil Kings defenceman Carter Sotheran has only played 14 games with the Edmonton Oil Kings since being acquired in a January trade from the Portland Winterhawks, but the 20-year-old blue liner has put himself into some special company after his game on February 6.

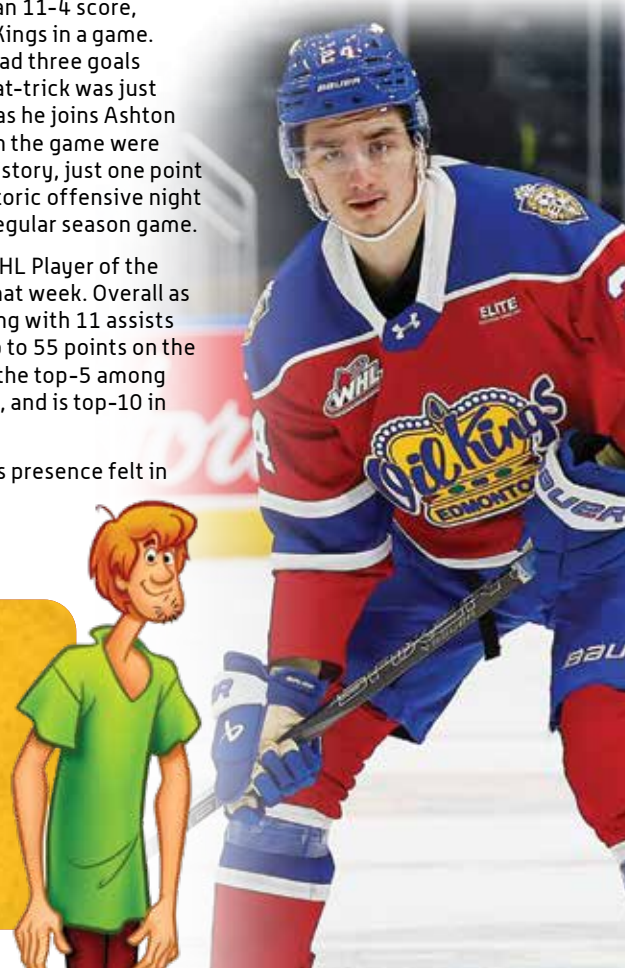
The Oil Kings defeated Moose Jaw that night by an 11-4 score, tied for the second most goals scored by the Oil Kings in a game. Offensively, the team was led by Sotheran who had three goals and two assists in the game for five points. His hat-trick was just the second in Oil Kings history by a defenceman as he joins Ashton Sautner as the only two to do it. His five points on the game were also the second most by a blueliner in Oil Kings history, just one point away from the record of six. Not only was it a historic offensive night for Sotheran, it was also his 250th consecutive regular season game.

That performance helped propel Sotheran to a WHL Player of the Week nod as he had seven points in two games that week. Overall as on Oil King, Sotheran has scored seven goals, along with 11 assists for 18 points and a +2 rating in 14 games. He's up to 55 points on the season, with 42 assists and 13 goals. He's inside the top-5 among WHL defencemen in points, leads them in assists, and is top-10 in goals.

The Sanford, Man. product has certainly made his presence felt in Edmonton in just over a month with the club.
