AUSTIN'S BACK HOME

AUSTIN ZEMLAK BRINGS VETERAN PRESENCE TO OIL KINGS BLUE LINE

When the Edmonton Oil Kings traded for Austin Zemlak from the Tri-City Americans, it not only added some veteran experience to the Oil Kings blue line, but also brought the defenceman back to the city where he played a large portion of his minor hockey.

Originally from Fort McMurray, Alta., Zemlak played his U15 hockey with the PAC Timberwolves in Spruce Grove and Okanagan Hockey Academy in Edmonton before being drafted in the first round, ninth-overall by the Victoria Royals. Zemlak then played one season of U18 with OHA before amassing a lengthy WHL career.

Zemlak played parts of four seasons with the Royals, playing 147 games before playing one season, 56 games with the Tri-City Americans in 2024/2025.

He totaled 58 points across 203 WHL games before going to the NCAA to begin this season.

The 20-year-old was then acquired by the Oil Kings and joined the club after the Christmas Break in December and has played 20 games with the Oil Kings scoring six points, including his first career two-goal game on New Year's Day.

Across parts of six WHL seasons, Zemlak has 64 points in 223 games and now gets to finish his WHL career for the team he cheered for growing up.
