Today's Matchup: The Regina Pats play the fifth game of their U.S., road trip, looking for their first win as the club is 0-4 to begin the road swing...the Pats are coming off a 8-3 loss to the Everett Silvertips on Saturday...meanwhile, the Portland Winterhawks are coming off a 2-1 loss to the Kelowna Rockets on Nov. 22.

Last Game: *Everett 8, Regina 3*...the Pats gave up a season-high eight goals against...Keets Fawcett, Caden Brown and Mathis Paull scored goals for Regina while Matthew Hutchison and Marek Schlenker split the action between the pipes...Hutchison allowed six goals on 24 shots while Schlenker gave up two goals on 15 shots...the Pats power play went 2-3 while the Silvertips power play was 4-5...the shots were 39-34 for Everett.

Coming Up: The Regina Pats finish their six game U.S. road trip on Saturday with a battle against the Wenatchee Wild...the Pats then travel back to the Queen City and prepare for their final four games before the Christmas Break...the Pats are back home on December 5 where they take on the Brandon What Kings.

Headlines:

Opponent: The Portland Winterhawks lost in the WHL final to the Moose Jaw Warriors in 2023-24 and followed that up with a deep playoff run in 2024-25, defeating Prince George and Everett in rounds one and two before being swept in the West Final to Spokane...since moving to Portland from Edmonton in 1976, the Winterhawks have been to 13 WHL finals, and have won three Ed Chynoweth Cups and two Memorial Cups.

The Pats take on the Winterhawks in Portland for the first time since March 1, 2024, falling 3-0...their last victory in Portland was Nov. 24, 2009 (W, 6-3)...the Pats last played the Winterhawks on January 11, 2025, losing 7-3 at the Brandt Centre after defeating them at home on January 14, 2023, winning 4-3 in regulation...the Pats are 1-8-1 against the Winterhawks since the 2013-14 season.

The Regina Pats have **won eight of their last 17 games**, posting a **8-7-1-1** record during that time since their 1-6-1 start...the Pats are now eighth in the Eastern Conference with 21 points this season...during their last 17 games, the Blue Brigade has outscored their opponents 65-to-64 with wins over Swift Current, Calgary, Moose Jaw (3x), Edmonton, Lethbridge and Brandon.

The Pats penalty kill is operating at 81% over their last seven games, going 21-for-26 during that time...meanwhile, the Pats power play has struck 13 times over their last nine games, going 13-for-38 during that time (34.2%).

The Blue Brigade has scored 34 goals in the third period this season, and have given up just 25 against, giving the club a +9 goal differential in third periods this season...in second periods, the Pats goal differential is -7, while in first periods they are -9.

Pats By the Numbers:

- 12** One goal games this season for the Regina Pats is tied with the Victoria Royals for the most one-goal games in the WHL...the Pats are 3-6-2-1 in one-goal games last season...16 of 25 games have been decided by two goals or less.
- 17** Goals for forward Keets Fawcett in 23 games (17G-10A-27PTS) this season after scoring just 10 goals in 63 games last season...the Grimshaw, Alta. product has tallied 14 goals and eight assists over his last 17 games, and 17 points over his last 11 games (10G-7A).
- 4** Pats players have more than 10 goals so far this season through 23 games (Brown 18, Fawcett 17, Maze 11, Lansard 10)...last season, the Pats had just five players with 10+ goals, with their team leader being Caden Brown with 19 goals.
- 18** Goals this season for 20-year-old forward Caden Brown is tied for first in the WHL...Brown is now two goals away from reaching the 20 goal mark for the first time in his WHL career, while also passing his career-high of 19 goals set last season...Brown has 55 points (33G-22A) in 67gms with Regina in career...he also has points in nine of last 11 games (9G-5A-14PTS).
- 10** Goals this season for Zach Lansard this season is a new career-high...the St. Anne, Man. product had his seven game point-streak end on Nov. 15 (5G-8A), but still has with 15 points over his last 12 games (5G-10A).

PATS EXTRAS...

- Liam Pue and Maddox Schultz, and Team Canada White won silver at the 2025 U17 World Hockey Challenge on Saturday...Schultz finished fifth in tournament scoring with 10 points (4G-6A)...Liam Pue finished seventh in tournament scoring with eight points (4G-4A).
- Caden Brown was named the WHL's Player of the Week on October 27...the 20-year-old product of Prince George, B.C., tallied eight points (5G-3A) and a plus-4 rating in three games...Oct. 25 at EDM, he recorded his first WHL hat-trick with the overtime winner.
- October 20, Eighty-nine players developed in the Western Hockey League have been named to NHL Central Scouting's Preliminary Players to Watch List ahead of the 2026 NHL Draft...which includes three forwards from the Regina Pats: **Cohen Klassen, Julien Maze, and Zach Lansard**. All three players received a "W" rating, indicating potential selection in the sixth or seventh round of the draft.
- September 19 at Swift Current, Liam Pue found the back of the net for his first WHL goal...the last time a 15-year-old scored in his league debut with the Pats was on March 12, 2021 when Connor Bedard scored two goals against the Prince Albert Raiders...current Pats goaltending coach Max Paddock was between the pipes for the Raiders as they won 6-3.
- Reese Hamilton attended two NHL development camps...first, he joined the Seattle Kraken in July for their rookie development camp, and later attended the Winnipeg Jets Prospect Showdown in September.
- The Pats announced their 2025-26 leadership on September 18, naming 20-year-old defenceman Ephram McNutt the 83rd captain in franchise history...joining McNutt as alternate captains are defenceman Kolten Bridgeman and forwards Zach Moore and Caden Brown.
- On June 24, the Regina Pats Hockey Club announced several changes to its Hockey Operations department...Alan Millar accepted a new role as the General Manager of Canada's National Junior Team, and Canada's National Men's Under-18 Team at both the Hlinka Gretzky Cup and IIHF U18 Men's World Championship...with Millar's departure, the Pats announced the promotion of Dale Derkatch to General Manager, making him the 21st GM in franchise history...in addition, Tristan Frei was promoted to Assistant General Manager, and Max Paddock was named Manager, Hockey Operations and Goaltending Coach.
- On May 7, the Pats made a trio of selections in the 2025 WHL Prospects Draft, selecting Maddox Schultz, Liam Pue and Logan Henry...that marked the first time in team history that the Pats selected multiple times in the first round...the Pats went into the draft with the first and 23rd overall picks but acquired the third overall pick from the Kelowna Rockets in exchange for the 26th overall pick in 2025, a first-round pick in 2026, and a first-round pick in 2027.
- The Regina Pats selected Maddox Schultz with the first overall pick of the 2025 WHL Prospects Draft on May 7...Schultz became the third player to be selected first overall by the Pats, joining Connor Bedard (2020) and Colten Teubert (2005)...Schultz had a monumental season as an underager with the Regina Pat Canadians in 2024-25, helping the C's capture their first Telus Cup Championship since 1999...the Regina, Sask. product was named the Telus Cup MVP, leading the tournament in goals (9), assists (11) and points (20) in just seven games...his 20 points in the tournament were the second most by an underager all-time, behind Sidney Crosby's 24 points in 2002...the left-shot forward tallied 93 points (43G-50A) in 44 games with the Pat Canadians this past season, leading the Saskatchewan Male AAA Hockey League in goals, assists, and points, where the 2010-born forward was named Player and Rookie of the Year.
- The Regina Pats finished the 2024-25 season with a 16-44-5-3 record and 40 points, which was second-last in the WHL...that led to the Pats winning the 2025 Draft Lottery on April 11, earning the first overall pick in the 2025 WHL Prospects Draft.
