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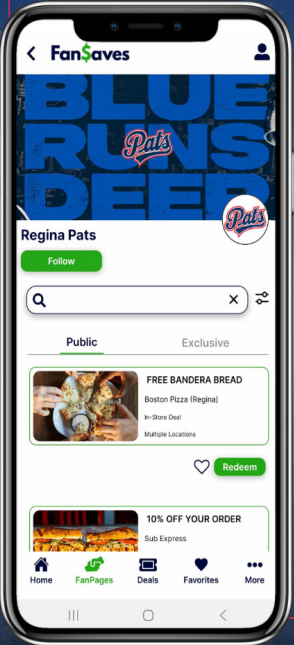
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PLAYER PROFILE

57 ZACH LANSARD

Zach Lansard has quietly become one of the most dependable offensive pieces for the Regina Pats, emerging as a key part of the Club's foundation as it builds toward becoming a consistent contender in the coming seasons.

The 17-year-old forward from Ste. Anne, Man., has taken a significant step forward in his sophomore WHL campaign. Lansard has already set career highs across the board, recording 31 points (14G-17A) in 36 games this season after posting 19 points (7G-12A) in 54 games as a 16-year-old rookie a year ago. His steady progression and impact earned him the Nick Pappas Award as the Pats' Rookie of the Year following the 2024-25 season.

Known primarily as a right winger, Lansard has shown an impressive willingness to adapt his game. Over the most recent stretch of the schedule, he has transitioned to centre, embracing the added responsibilities that come with the position. The move has paid immediate dividends, as Lansard has collected nine points (4G-5A) over his last nine games, while continuing to drive play through the middle of the ice.

As Regina continues to shape its core for the future, the Ste. Anne product's development and offensive reliability position him as a player the organization can build around for years to come.

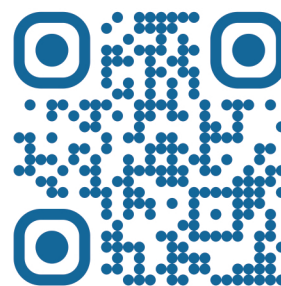

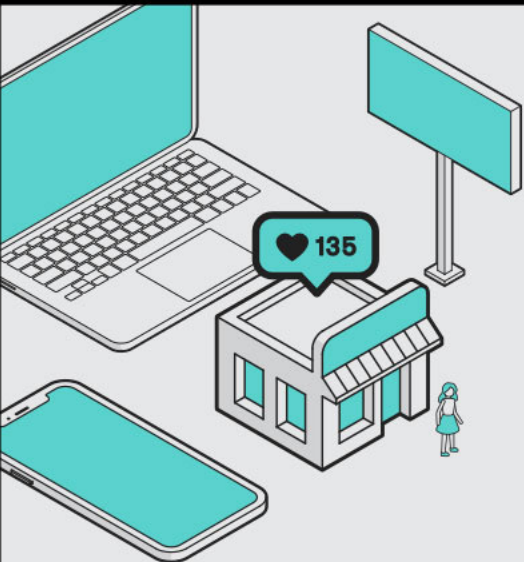

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SCOUTING REPORT



RED DEER REBELS

The Red Deer Rebels arrive for tonight's matchup clinging to the final playoff position in the Eastern Conference, sitting one point ahead of the Regina Pats for eighth with 28 points.

After missing the postseason last year for the first time since 2019-20, Red Deer entered this season aiming to re-establish its identity. The Rebels finished 2024-25 with a 26-34-6-2 record and 60 points, and while this year has brought its share of challenges, they remain firmly in the playoff race at 12-20-2-2.

Red Deer is trending in the right direction heading into tonight's contest. The Rebels are coming off an impressive 4-0 shutout victory over the Brandon Wheat Kings and have now won back-to-back games, also earning a 5-3 win over the Seattle Thunderbirds prior to the trip. Tonight marks the second game of a three-game Eastern Division road swing.

Following the January 9 trade deadline, the Rebels signaled a shift toward the future, moving out several veterans and key pieces in Samuel Drancak, Noah Milford, Matthew Gard, Luke Vlooswyk, Keith McInnis and Jaxon Fuder. The moves have ushered in a younger, retooling lineup.



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PLAYER TO WATCH

31 PEYTON SHORE

Red Deer Rebels goaltender Peyton Shore continues to show his upside between the pipes, most recently turning in a standout performance with a 35-save shutout against the Brandon Wheat Kings on Wednesday. The victory marked the second shutout of Shore's WHL career and his first of the 2025-26 season.

The Winnipeg, Man. native first broke through with his initial WHL shutout on Jan. 31 last season, stopping all 18 shots he faced against the Regina Pats. Now in his 17-year-old season, Shore has taken on a larger role in Red Deer's crease, appearing in 12 games to date. He owns a 4-6-0-1 record with a 3.81 goals-against average and a .877 save percentage, numbers that reflect both his workload and his ability to deliver strong performances, particularly when tested heavily.

Selected by the Rebels in the fifth round of the 2023 WHL Prospects Draft, Shore's development path has been marked by steady progression. He began last season with the Virden Oil Capitals of the MJHL, where he quickly established himself as a reliable presence. In six appearances, Shore posted a 4-2-0 record with one shutout, along with a 2.13 GAA and an impressive .920 save percentage, earning a mid-season call-up and a full-time opportunity with Red Deer.
