Today's Matchup: The Regina Pats are back in action tonight against the Edmonton Oil Kings at Rogers Place, marking the second game of their Alberta swing...the Pats are 3-1-1 over their last five games while the Oil Kings are 9-1-0-1 over their last 11 games since the break.

Last Game: Red Deer 2, Regina 1 (OT)...Kalder Varga scored at 3:14 of the extra-frame to secure the extra point for Red Deer...Marek Schlenker bounced back with 44 saves on 46 shots...Rebels goaltender Matthew Kondro picked up the win with 29 saves on 30 shots...Caden Brown set a new career-high with his 20th of the season, his first in nine games...the Pats were 1-8 on their power play and 6-7 on their penalty kill.

Coming Up: The Regina Pats continue their road trip on Friday in Lethbridge and will wrap up on Saturday in Calgary...the Pats wrap up a stretch of five straight road games on Friday, December 30 at Swift Current...the Pats next home game is Saturday, January 31 versus Moose Jaw.

Headlines:

Opponent: The Edmonton Oil Kings are in the thick of a three team race for first in the Eastern Conference, battling with Medicine Hat and Prince Albert...the Oil Kings are one point back of Prince Albert for second and two points back of Medicine Hat for first...the Oil Kings are coming off a 5-4 win over the Tri-City Americans on Saturday, and are 9-1-0-1 over their last 11 games dating back to December 27.

It's the third of four meetings between the Regina Pats and Edmonton Oil Kings...the Pats are 1-1 against the Oil Kings this season with a 4-3 loss in their first meeting followed by a 5-4 overtime win on Oct. 25...the Pats went 1-2-1-0 against the Oil Kings last season with two of their four meetings going to overtime or shootout...the Pats are 6-10-1 against the Oil Kings since the 2021-22 season.

The Regina Pats are 3-1-1 over their last five games with victories over Red Deer (5-2), Brandon (6-3) and Swift Current (7-0), good for 21 goals for, and 12 against (+9)...during that time, the Pats have allowed no goals in the third period.

Cohen Klassen and Zach Lansard were both named to NHL Central Scouting's Midterm Rankings ahead of the 2026 NHL Draft on January 12...Lansard is ranked 72nd (potential third round pick) and Klassen is ranked 142nd (potential fifth round pick)...In total, 78 players developed in the Western Hockey League appeared on the Midterm Rankings

The Pats have posted a 10-8-2-1 record against the Eastern Division this season, and a 4-4-2 record against the Central Division, good for an overall record of 14-12-4-1 record against the Eastern Conference...the Pats have two more out of conference games left this season.

Pats By the Numbers:

14 Points (5G-9A) for Zach Lansard over his last 13 contests, with four multi-point games...Lansard also has seven points over his last seven games (2G-5A) and has tallied a career-high 36 points (15G-21A) in 41 games this season.

22 Goals for forward Keets Fawcett in 32 games (22G-15A-37PTS) is a new career-high...the Grimshaw, Alta. has 27 points over his last 20 games (15G-12A), and had his career-high 10 game point-streak end last night (7G-5A).

32 The Pats power play has struck 32 times over their last 25 games (32-for-95 during that time - 33.6%), and 17 times over their last 14 games...the Pats power play has scored the second most power play goals in the WHL (47).

37 Points this season for 20-year-old forward Caden Brown is tied for first on the Pats...Brown set a new career-high with his 20th goal of the season on Jan. 20 at Red Deer...Brown has 65 points (35G-30A) in 77 games with Regina in his career...he also has points in 17 of last 21 games (11G-13A-24PTS).

33 Points (8G-24A) in 41 games for Pats captain Ephram McNutt is a new career-high after he totaled 29 points (8G-23A) in 52 games last season...the 20-year-old defenceman has 14 points (4G-10A) over his last 14 games, and seven points over his last six games (2G-5A).
