Today's Matchup: The Regina Pats finish a stretch of five straight road games tonight as they take on the Swift Current Broncos for the fifth time this season...the Pats have dropped their last two games, and are coming off a 6-3 loss to the Calgary Hitmen on Saturday, ending their four game Alberta swing.

Last Game: *Calgary 6, Regina 3*...the Pats went down 3-1 after one, and both teams traded goals in the second period, making it 5-3 after 40 minutes...Keets Fawcett recorded a Gordie Howe hat-trick with 1G-1A + 1 Fight, and Matt Paranych chipped in with two assists...Zachary Lansard and Connor Bear rounded out the scoring while Marek Schlenker made 34 saves...the shots were 43-40 for Regina...the Pats were 1-5 on their power play and 0-2 on their penalty kill.

Coming Up: The Regina Pats return home on Saturday, January 31 as they take on the Moose Jaw Warriors at 6pm...that will be the first of three straight home games for the Blue Brigade where they will host Saskatoon on February 6 and Calgary on February 7.

Headlines:

Pats **Opponents:** The Swift Current Broncos sit last in the WHL standings with a 11-31-3-0 record and just 25 points this season...the Broncos broke a 16 game losing-streak on January 3 with a 7-4 win over the Lethbridge Hurricanes, marking their first win since November 14 vs. Moose Jaw (4-3 SOW)...since then, the Broncos are 3-5-1 over their last nine games.

Pats It's the fifth of six meetings between the Pats and Broncos this season...last season, the Pats went 3-3-0 against the Broncos, with the Pats outscoring the Broncos 23-to-19...since the 2021-22 season, the Pats are 13-14-1, going 8-6 at home and 5-8-1 on the road during that time...the Pats are 18-17-2 over their last 37 meetings versus Swift Current.

Pats The Regina Pats are 4-3-1 over their last eight games with victories over Red Deer (5-2), Brandon (6-3), Swift Current (7-0) and Edmonton (4-3) good for 30 goals for, and 27 against (+3)...during that time, the Pats have outscored opponents 8-to-3 in the third period.

Pats Cohen Klassen and Zach Lansard were both named to NHL Central Scouting's Midterm Rankings ahead of the 2026 NHL Draft on January 12...Lansard is ranked 72nd (potential third round pick) and Klassen is ranked 142nd (potential fifth round pick)...In total, 78 players developed in the Western Hockey League appeared on the Midterm Rankings

Pats The Pats have posted a 10-8-2-1 record against the Eastern Division this season, and a 5-6-2 record against the Central Division, good for an overall record of 15-14-4-1 record against the Eastern Conference...the Pats have two more out of conference games left this season.

Pats By the Numbers:

17 Points (6G-11A) for Zach Lansard over his last 16 contests, with five multi-point games...Lansard also has 10 points over his last 10 games (3G-7A)...the Ste. Anne, Man. product will represent the Pats at the 2026 WHL Prospects Game on Feb. 18.

23 Goals for forward Keets Fawcett in 35 games (23G-16A-39PTS) is a new career-high...the Grimshaw, Alta. has 29 points over his last 23 games (16G-13A), and had his career-high 10 game point-streak end on Jan 20 at RD (7G-5A).

4 Points in four straight games for overage forward Caden Brown, with four points (2G-2A) during that time...Brown is second on the Pats with a career-high 21 goals this season, and has points in five of his last six games (2G-4A-6PTS).

35 The Pats power play has struck 35 times over their last 28 games (35-for-112 during that time - 31.25%), and 20 times over their last 17 games...the Pats power play has also scored in 11 straight games, and has scored the second most power play goals in the WHL (50), and are operating with the eighth best PP% at 27.3%.

33 Points (9G-24A) in 44 games for Pats captain Ephram McNutt is a new career-high after he totaled 29 points (8G-23A) in 52 games last season...the 20-year-old defenceman has 15 points (5G-10A) over his last 17 games, and eight points over his last 10 games (3G-5A).
