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# PLAYER PROFILE

## 55 EPHRAM MCNUTT

As his junior career winds down, Ephram McNutt leaves behind a legacy of leadership, consistency, and steady growth during his time in the Western Hockey League.

The 20-year-old defenceman from Ponoka County, Alberta will play the final games of his WHL career this weekend, bringing to a close a four-season journey that has seen him develop into one of the most reliable blue-liners for the Regina Pats.

Over 235 career WHL games split between the Pats and the Prince George Cougars, McNutt compiled 104 points (22 goals, 82 assists), steadily evolving into a two-way defender capable of contributing in all situations.

This year marked the most productive campaign of McNutt's WHL career. Serving as captain, he recorded a career-high 52 points (12 goals, 40 assists), finishing fifth in team scoring while leading the Pats in assists. His strong offensive output also placed him among the top 15 defencemen in scoring across the league.

Beyond the numbers, McNutt's leadership has been just as impactful. Wearing the "C" for Regina, he provided guidance for one of the WHL's younger rosters, helping mentor emerging players.

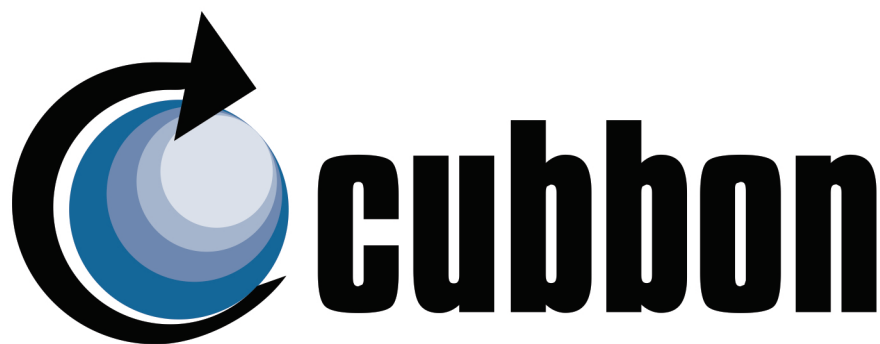

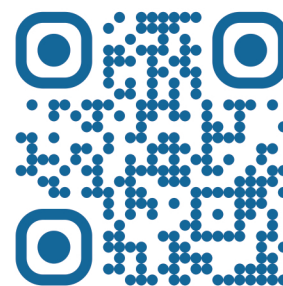

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# SCOUTING REPORT



## BRANDON WHEAT KINGS

The Brandon Wheat Kings close out the regular season this weekend with plenty still to play for, entering action with a 38-26-2-0 record and 78 points. That mark has them sitting fifth in the Eastern Conference standings, with their playoff position all but locked in heading into the final games of the campaign.

All signs point to a first-round matchup with the Calgary Hitmen, who currently occupy the fourth seed. With the postseason set to begin next week, this weekend presents one final opportunity for the Wheat Kings to fine-tune their game before what is expected to be a tightly contested series between two evenly matched Clubs.

Brandon's roster features a strong mix of emerging talent and experience, highlighted by four players recognized by NHL Central Scouting. Giorgos Pantelas, Joby Baumuler, Cameron Allard, and Filip Ruzicka have all drawn attention ahead of the upcoming NHL Draft, underlining the depth of talent within the lineup.

The Wheat Kings also boast a strong academic and development pipeline, with nine players committed to NCAA programs. Their trio of 20-year-olds are all set to make the jump to the next level, including Nicholas Johnson (Ferris State Bulldogs), Luke Mistelbacher (Maine Black Bears), and Grayson Burzynski (RPI Engineers).



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# PLAYER TO WATCH

## 30 FILIP RUZICKA

Brandon Wheat Kings goaltender Filip Ruzicka has emerged as one of the most intriguing young netminders in the WHL. The 17-year-old Trinec, Czechia product stands an imposing 6-foot-7 and 230 pounds. His play has not gone unnoticed, as NHL Central Scouting currently ranks him 13th among North American goaltenders ahead of the 2026 NHL Draft.

In his first season in Brandon, Ruzicka has delivered steady and impactful results, posting a 25-14-1 record along with a 3.22 goals-against average and a .906 save percentage, adding two shutouts. His save percentage ranks tied for fifth in the WHL.

Ruzicka has been especially sharp down the stretch. Over his last 10 games, he has posted a stellar .929 save percentage while going 5-3-1, providing the Wheat Kings with a reliable backbone as they push toward the postseason.

Before making the jump to the WHL, Ruzicka starred with Mountfield HK's U17 program in Czechia, where he went 23-15-0 with five shutouts, a 1.80 goals-against average, and an outstanding .943 save percentage.
