JOB PURPOSE

The game day host position plays a key role in the facilitation of the Sarnia Sting game day experience. The position will follow along a game script to execute scripted speeches and help lead fan-engaging activations both on-ice and in the stands to increase fan interaction throughout each game. Game day hosts play integral roles in promoting fan engagement as well as delivering on corporate partner promotions.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work with the Coordinator, Marketing & Game Presentation, other Game Day Hosts, and members of the Sting game day team in executing game day activations.
- Attend a majority of Sarnia Sting home games
- Follow a game script to fulfill in-game promotions
- Interact with fans for in-game entertainment, helping communicate the unique story around each individual game.
- Communicate with the Coordinator, Marketing & Game Presentation for special requests
- Other duties as assigned

WORKING CONDITIONS

This position requires regular evening and weekend work, as dictated by the Sarnia Sting home calendar for the season. The Game Day host will be given a script to follow and make their way around the arena interacting with fans to be displayed on the jumbotron.
