JOB DESCRIPTION

As members of the Sting Game Day Team, Video Production Operators will be responsible for helping oversee and lead the in-game video production of all Sting home games. These individuals will support this objective by keeping fans informed, entertained and engaged throughout each game using the Launchpad by MotionRocket and vMix softwares to manage the graphics, videos, and replays displayed following provided game scripts while working with volunteers.

- Attend all Sarnia Sting home games
- Operate the four-sided videoboard and LED displays in the arena utilizing the LaunchPad by MotionRocket or vMix software
- Support the execution of sponsorship activations and fan-engaging activities as part of the Sting in-game experience
- Lead the use of variable video content throughout each game including the use of fan cam shots and replays
