JOB PURPOSE

Reporting to the Manager, Corporate Partnerships, Coordinator, Group Sales & Ticket Service, Coordinator, Marketing & Game Presentation and Coordinator, Marketing & Community Engagement, Game Operations Interns will contribute to the execution of key initiatives across multiple departments. Interns will have the opportunity to build their skills and gain practical experience in areas such as:

- **Marketing & Content Creation** – Support the development of creative content for social media platforms through in-game filming and editing.
- **Video Editing & Highlights** – Use broadcast software to clip game footage and create highlight packages for the team and league websites.
- **Group Experiences** – Help coordinate special group initiatives such as the OHL Experience, Chuck-a-Puck Fundraisers, and birthday party activations.
- **Corporate Activations** – Support the fulfillment and tracking of sponsor obligations, including gathering proof of performance materials.
- **Statistics Tracking** – Live-track select in-game stats and report to the Ontario Hockey League to ensure real-time updates on the CHL app.
- **Additional Duties** – Support other areas of the organization as needed to contribute to overall game day success.

- Assist in the filming, editing, and publishing of content for the team's social media channels.
- Participate in the setup and execution of in-game promotions, both on-ice and in the stands.
- Support the Game Day Production team by fulfilling various control room roles such as Fan Cam Operator.
- Capture and edit game footage to create highlight packages for internal use and league-wide platforms.
- Facilitate group game day experiences such as anthem programs, birthday parties, and intermission showcases.
- Assist with corporate partnership fulfillment by gathering proof of performance materials and tracking deliverables.
- Track and report live in-game statistics to the OHL to ensure accurate and timely updates on the CHL App.
- Engage with fans and contribute to a positive, high-energy game day environment.
- Perform additional tasks as assigned to support various departments within the organization.
