



GAME NOTES

THE LAST SEASON: The Thunderbirds finished with a 30-33-4-1 record a season ago, finishing fifth in the U.S. Division and 8th in the Western Conference. Seattle finished last season 18-8-1-1 over their last 28 games to climb into the 8th seed. They lost in the first round of the playoffs to Everett in six games.

SEASON SERIES: This is fourth and final of six meetings between the T-Birds and Penticton. The T-Birds are currently 0-3 against the Veeps. Seattle lost twice on the road, losing 10-4 in Penticton on October 4th. The T-Birds were doubled up, 4-2 in Penticton November 7th. The Veeps first ever game at the accesso ShoWare Center was on December 12th and they skated away with a 5-1 win.

TALE OF THE TAPE: Matej Pekar is the T-Birds leading scorer in the series versus the Veeps with three goals in three games. Ashton Cumby and Antonio Martorana each have two assists. Through three games of the season series the T-Birds are 1-for-11 on the power play while Penticton is 4-for-14 with the man advantage. The Veeps have outshot Seattle in the series, 112-75 and average of 37-25 per game. Through 180 minutes against Penticton, Seattle has led for just 41 seconds..

LAST GAME: Seattle got a goal from Matthew Gard but lost, 5-1, last night against the Everett Silvertips at Climate Pledge Arena in Seattle in the annual Battle of the Sound. The T-Birds surrendered three power play goals while going 0-for-3 with the man advantage.

2025 NHL ENTRY DRAFT: Three Thunderbirds heard their names called at this past summer's NHL Entry Draft. Radim Mrtka was chosen 9th overall in the first round by the Buffalo Sabres. Center Braeden Cootes, traded recently to Prince Albert, was chosen 15th overall in round one by the Vancouver Canucks and Ashton Cumby was taken by the Chicago Blackhawks, 162nd overall, in the sixth round.

GONE CAMPING: Eight Thunderbirds participated in NHL rookie/training camps this month. In addition to Mrtka, Cootes and Cumby, Coster Dunn (Utah), Hyde Davidson (Edmonton), Caleb Hartmann (Winnipeg), Brayden Holberton (Minnesota) and Scott Ratzlaff (Buffalo) were all in camp with NHL teams.

TRADE FRENZY: Seattle made a number of trades in the week leading up to the WHL trade deadline earlier this month. They traded Cameron Kuzma and three draft picks to Red Deer for Matthew Gard. They then dealt Hyde Davidson and a prospect to Swift Current for Brennen Hoher and a prospect and sent Kaleb Hartmann and five picks to Vancouver for Cameron Schmidt. The next day they sent Braeden Cootes to Prince Albert for Ethan Bibeau, three prospects and four draft picks. Seattle traded Brendan Rudolph and two draft picks to Swift Current in exchange for Noah Kosick and traded Jaxon Pawlenchuk to Vancouver for Caden Cail.

CHAMPIONS PEDIGREE: The Thunderbirds have played in four of the last eight WHL Championship series. The T-Birds lost the final to Brandon in 2016 then defeated Regina in 2017. Seattle was eliminated in the first round of the postseason in both 2018 and 2019. Due to Covid, the Ed Chynoweth Cup was not contested in 2020 or 2021. The Thunderbirds then fell to the Edmonton Oil Kings in the 2022 WHL Championship Series before defeating Winnipeg (now Wenatchee) in 2023. Seattle also won the WHL Western Conference Championship in 1997 before losing the WHL Championship Series to Lethbridge.



GAME NOTES

BENCH BOSS: This is Matt O'Dette's ninth season as the head coach of the Thunderbirds. With the T-Birds win on January 21st, 2025, at home over Vancouver, he set the record for most coaching wins in franchise history with 239 (now 272-223-28-15), surpassing Rob Sumner. O'Dette has been on the Thunderbirds bench as the head coach or an assistant for 13 seasons, a span that includes two WHL championships, four Western Conference titles and two U.S. Division banners. O'Dette's postseason head coaching record is 35-25.

VERSUS THE B.C DIVISION: This is Seattle's 19th game this season against a B.C. Division opponent. The T-Birds are currently 6-10-2-0, including a 4-3-1-0 home record.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN: Of the 23 players currently on the T-Birds roster, eight (Cumby, Mayes, Gard, Bibeau, Hocher, Kosick, Schmidt and Cail) were acquired via trade. Three (Pekar, Sklenicka and Mrtka), were selected in the CHL Import Draft. Seattle's roster currently features three 20-year-olds (2005s), one 19 year old (2006), twelve 18 year olds (2007s), four 17 year olds (2008s) and three 16 year olds (2009s).

RIDING THE ROLLERCOASTER: Before last night's loss, Seattle's had won Tuesday stopping a two game skid. Prior to that the Thunderbirds had points in three straight games (2-0-1-0). Seattle is 5-7-1-1 since returning from the Christmas break. They had sandwiched the break with a five game point streak (3-0-0-2). That came after a six game losing streak, which was preceded by a 6-0-1-0 stretch. While the Thunderbirds are 14-6-3-0 at home (.674), they are just 4-15-0-2 on the road (.238).

WHO'S HOT: Cameron Schmidt's season best 27 game point streak ended last Saturday in Everett but he followed that with a two assist game Tuesday. Since being acquired by Seattle, Schmidt has eleven points in nine games (5g, 6a) plus a shootout game winner. Matthew Gard has goals in five of his last six games. He has points in seven of nine games since being acquired by Seattle. Sawyer Mayes had scored two goals in back-to-back games prior to being held off the scoresheet last night.

MILESTONES: Cameron Schmidt's first goal as a T-Bird January 7th in Lethbridge, was his 100th in the WHL. His goal January 9th in Medicine Hat earned him his 200th WHL point. He also now has over 100 WHL assists after assisting on the T-Birds second goal in Medicine Hat.

LOV TO C IT: The T-Birds named Simon Lovsin their captain after the departure of Cootes in the trade to Prince Albert. Lovsin was a second round pick of the T-Birds (44th overall) in the 2021 WHL Prospects Draft.

OF KOS HE CAN: Thunderbird forward Noah Kosick is one of 44 NHL Draft eligible players who will compete at the 2026 WHL Prospects Game. The game will take place February 18th in Langley, B.C.

GOOD GRAMER: The T-Birds have signed 20 year old defenseman Joe Gramer. Gramer played the past two seasons with the University of Nebraska-Omaha. Gramer hails from Moorhead MN.

CENTRAL SCOUTING: Two T-Birds, Noah Kosick (55th among North American skaters) and Marek Sklenicka (8th among North American goalies) made NHL Central Scouting's Midterm rankings for the 2026 NHL Draft.

NEXT GAMES: The T-Birds will play a home and home next weekend against the Portland Winterhawks. They host the Winterhawks Friday at 7:05 p.m. They will be in Portland Saturday at 6:05 p.m.
