Friday, March 20th, 2026 | Sudbury Wolves vs. Brampton Steelheads

With the final regular-season home game tonight, the Sudbury Wolves will be welcoming a familiar foe to town, the Brampton Steelheads. The Wolves are preparing for their fourth straight postseason, this year against the Brantford Bulldogs. The Steelheads are looking to keep developing their young core for next season. Brampton is coming into Sudbury looking to bounce back after a tough 7-0 loss last night in North Bay. Sudbury is looking to get back into the win column before they head into the playoffs. The Wolves enter today’s matchup sitting 4th in the Central Division with a record of 26-38-2-0, including a 18-13-2-0 record at home, and a 8-25-0-0 record on the road. The Steelheads are currently positioned 5th in the Central Division, with an 18-29- 6- 3 record, a road record of 7-21-4-1.

Kieran Witkowski has continued to show steady development as a dependable offensive piece for the Brampton Steelheads, taking another step forward in his OHL career this season with 11 goals and 19 assists for 30 points in 60 games. The 2007-born forward’s growth has been apparent year over year, improving from 3 goals and 4 assists in 58 games as a rookie in 2023-24 to 12 goals and 18 assists for 30 points in 68 games last season. With his consistent progression and growing confidence with the puck, Witkowski projects as a player who can continue to elevate his production and emerge as a key top-six contributor for the Steelheads next season.

Hudson Martin has established himself as a steady presence on the back end for the Sudbury Wolves in his first OHL season, bringing reliability and composure to the blue line. The 2007-born defenceman has appeared in 60 games this season, recording 1 goal and 13 assists for 14 points, while adding a physical edge and logging consistent minutes in a depth role. Drafted in the 13th round of the 2023 OHL Priority Selection, Martin arrived in Sudbury following a championship run with the Greater Sudbury Cubs (NOJHL) and time with the Collingwood Blues (OJHL), showcasing a strong development path prior to making the jump to the OHL. Known for his defensive reliability and puck-moving ability, he has continued to adjust to the pace of major junior hockey. Martin is well-positioned to take on a larger role moving forward. He is committed to Bowling Green State University for the 2027–28 season.

REGULAR SEASON WRAP-UP GIVES WAY TO POST-SEASON HOCKEY – Randy Pascal

Just two regular-season games remain for the Sudbury Wolves this year: one at home and one on the road. And for a fourth straight year, the Wolves will follow up the end of their 68-game schedule with some postseason hockey.

BEING SUPERIOR TO THE STEELHEADS SHOULD BE THE GOAL – Randy Pascal

Yes, the Sudbury Wolves have managed to finish ahead of the Brampton Steelheads in 2025-2026 (as well as the Oshawa Generals) – but a season series win over the newly relocated divisional rivals can only be ensured with a home ice win on Friday.

The local juniors will be looking to extend their winning streak on home ice versus the Steelheads to four games, just over the halfway mark, as they chase down their all-time best stretch of seven straight victories at home from 2011 to 2014.

That run kicked off thanks to an early third-period goal from Josh Leivo, propelling Sudbury past what were then the Mississauga St Michael’s Majors 4-3 in November of 2011, with Mathew Campagna, Michael Sgarbossa and Kristoff Kontos also hitting the scoresheet for the winners.

Their seventh win would come on January 10th (2014) as Sudbury doubled the now Steelheads 4-2, bolting to a 3-0 first period lead on goals from Nicholas Baptiste, Mathew Campagna and Ray Huether, with Nathan Pancel adding an insurance marker later on.

NORTHERN RIVALRY EXTENDS LATE IN THE YEAR – Randy Pascal

The Wolves will play their 68th and final regular season game of 2025-2026 on the road against the North Bay Battalion on Sunday afternoon – marking the second straight year in which these two northern rivals close out their campaigns with a tete-a-tete in the Gateway City.

In fact, in each of the 11 previous seasons, the Wolves and Battalion have met at least once every March – assuming you include 2019-2020, which had a Sudbury-North Bay matchup on the docket for March 17th, cancelled due to Covid. Their eighth and final meeting of 2012-2013 actually came on February 8th, in Sudbury, when Blake Clarke closed the books on a 2-1 shootout win for the visitors as the only one of the six shooters to find the back of the net.

The latest regular-season battle between these two well-acquainted franchises came in 2022-2023, the year in which the Wolves' schedule did not start until October 8th, coming out of Covid. On April 15th (2022), the Battalion rode second-period strikes from Dalyn Wakely, Grayson Ladd and Liam Arnsby to a 3-1 win, with only Dominik Jendek able to solve North Bay netminder Dom DiVincentiis on that particular Friday evening in Sudbury.

GAME NIGHT & PROMOTIONS

Tonight marks the Wolves' final home game of the regular season, proudly sponsored by the YMCA. The game will be a special one. Prior to puck drop, the Wolves will recognize their overage players who are playing in their final OHL regular-season home game. We will be celebrating forward Chase Coughlan and defenceman Gavin Ewles. We thank both players for their leadership and commitment to the team during their time with the Wolves.

LOOKING AHEAD

Following tonight's game, the Wolves head to North Bay to close out the regular season against their rivals. The action kicks off against the Battalion at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, March 22nd. Fans can follow the Wolves on the road by streaming games live with FloHockey at www.flohockey.tv.

PLAYER BIOS



1 KARSEN CHARTIER

Chartier was acquired by the Wolves at the 2025 OHL Trade Deadline. Originally drafted 91st overall in the fifth round of the 2022 OHL Priority Selection by the Sarnia Sting, he made his OHL debut in 2023-24, posting a 7-11-1-0 record with a 4.55 goals against average and an .846 save percentage with Sarnia. Chartier spent the 2024-25 season split between the Strathroy Rockets (GOJHL) and the Greater Sudbury Cubs (NOJHL). With the Cubs, he was outstanding, recording an 11-1-0-0 record with a 1.76 GAA and a .940 save percentage in the regular season, before backstopping the team to an NOJHL Championship with an 11-2-0-0 record in the playoffs.



29 PAOLO FRASCA

Frasca was acquired by Sudbury in November of the 2025-26 season, originally selected in the 11th round, 222nd overall in the 2022 OHL Priority Selection by the Windsor Spitfires, Frasca has spent the past few seasons developing through the Toronto Junior Canadiens AAA program at the U16 and U18 levels, and with St. Andrews College following. Frasca's time with the Junior Canadiens was highlighted by an OHL Cup finals appearance in 2021-2022 at the U16 level, and a 2022-23 season which saw Frasca post an impressive 1.65 GAA and a .927 save percentage over 33 games at the U18 level. Frasca spent the 2024-25 season with St. Andrews College, posting an impressive 26-6-1 record with a 1.98 GAA and a .935 save percentage, standing as one of the league's top goaltenders.



30 OWEN LEONARD

Selected 66th overall in the fourth round of the 2025 OHL Priority Selection, the Toronto native played his minor hockey with the Toronto Titans AAA program from U14 through U16, where he developed into one of the top goaltenders in his age group. In his 2024-25 season with the Titans U16 team, Leonard posted an impressive 34-9-1 record with a 1.51 goals against average and a .926 save percentage.



31 BJÖRN BRONÄS

Bronäs was selected 89th overall in the fifth round of the 2023 OHL Priority Selection. Bronäs has played his last two seasons with the Sioux City Musketeers (USHL). As one of the youngest goalies in the USHL last season, he made 25 appearances, going 9-7-2-5 with a .894 save percentage and a 3.12 GAA. On the 2026 NHL Central Scouting Preliminary Players to Watch List released in October, Bronäs was ranked a 'W' prospect for the upcoming 2026 NHL Draft. A product of the Chicago Mission program, Bronäs has taken part in multiple USA Selects tournaments, along with USA Hockey's 2025 Chipotle All-American Game, where he made nine saves on nine shots in just over 30 minutes of action for Team Blue, helping them to a 3-2 win. Bronäs immediately made an impact in his OHL debut on November 21st, stopping 32 of 35 shots and earning first star honours in a 6-3 win over London.



2 FINN KEARNS

Selected 154th overall in the eighth round of the 2024 OHL Priority Selection, Kearns saw action in five games with the Wolves during the 2024-25 season. Berehowsky's bloodline runs deep in hockey. His father, Drake, had a long pro career playing 549 NHL games. Drake now serves as the assistant coach for the Sudbury Wolves. The Longwood, Florida native developed through the Honeybaked AAA program, where he recorded 82 points (39 goals and 43 assists) in 65 games at the U15 level and added 35 points (19 goals and 16 assists) the following season at U16. His dominance at the minor hockey level earned him an invitation to represent the USA Select 15 team in 2021. In the 2024-25 season, Berehowsky split time between the Guelph Storm and the Ayr Centennials (GOJHL). With the Centennials, he tallied 47 points (22 goals and 25 assists) in 40 games.



57 BRADY SMITH

Chosen 111th overall in the sixth round of the 2024 OHL Priority Selection, Brady Smith is set for his first full-time campaign on the Wolves blueline in the 2025-26 season. The Oshawa native captained the Oshawa Generals U16 AAA team in 2023-24, where he posted 53 points (10 goals and 43 assists) in 75 games and added two assists in five games at the OHL Cup, showcasing both his leadership and strong two-way play. Smith spent the 2024-25 season with the Stouffville Spirit (OJHL), where he recorded 13 points (two goals and 11 assists) in 13 games.

66 JEAN-CHRISTOPH LEMIEUX

Hailing from Gatineau, Lemieux developed through the Quinte Red Devils and Greater Kingston Gaels AAA programs. During the 2023-24 season, he suited up for the Quinte Red Devils at the U16 level, recording 24 goals and 36 assists for 60 points in 35 games, which ranked him seventh in OMHA scoring. He continued his strong play into the postseason, adding five goals and 14 assists for 19 points in nine playoff games to cap off an impressive campaign.

With the Jr. Canadiens in 2023-24, he recorded 51 points (24 goals and 27 assists) in 35 games, establishing himself as an offensive threat. In his U15 season, he led the league in goals (26), assists (21), and points (47) over just 25 games, earning the Mike Zuke Memorial Trophy as league MVP. He followed that up with a standout U18 campaign, finishing second in league scoring with 22 goals and 26 assists for 48 points in 28 games. Before joining the Wolves full-time, Chitaroni spent the 2023-24 season with the Greater Sudbury Cubs (NOJHL) alongside his brother Mason and Wolves teammate Hudson Martin. Chitaroni had a remarkable rookie year with the Cubs, scoring 31 goals and 46 assists for 77 points in 55 games, all of which led the league among rookies.
