

### **FAQ - Timbits Jamboree**

Q: Is there an additional fee to enter the Jamboree?

A: No, the Timbits Jamboree is free to enter!

#### Q: Are coaches allowed on the ice?

**A:** 1 coach per team can be on the ice to assist with getting players on and off the ice in between plays, but must have skates and a helmet on. All remaining coaches must remain on the players benches during play. Please remember, we will have 1 Giants Player assigned to each team who can assist and play with your team's players.

Q: How many goalies per team?

**A:** Only 1 goalie per team.

# Q: How many parents are allowed in the dressing room to help get the players dressed?

**A:** We ask only 1 parent/guardian per player to be in the dressing rooms.

### Q: What happens if a player is late?

**A:** If a player is late, please let a Giants Representative know. Once the player arrives, we will direct them to their team's dressing room. If the player misses the Team Photo, we will try to get them on the ice as soon as possible

#### Q: Who is signing their team in upon arrival?

**A:** The Head Coach or Team Manager will sign in and then be given further instructions to pass on to their team from the Giants Representative at the sign in tables.

#### Q: Can players bring water bottles?

**A:** Players can have their own water bottles. All water bottles are to be given to one of your team's coaches prior to the Team Photo. After the Team Photo, the coach can bring the water bottles to the benches.

#### Q: Do players have helmets on or off during the Team Photo?

**A:** We ask that all players keep helmets on at all times, including during the Team Photo.

## Q: Where do parents/guardians/family members/friends go to watch the games?

**A:** As each fully dressed team is being escorted to the Team Photo, a Giants Representative will direct anyone who is not a coach or player to the stairs and escalators that will take them to the concourse level where parents/family members/friends can find a seat and enjoy the games.
