VANCOUVER GIANTS (7-8-0-1) vs. PRINCE GEORGE COUGARS (9-5-0-0)

SCENE SETTER

The Vancouver Giants face the Prince George Cougars this afternoon in the first of four meetings this season. The Giants are coming off a 5-2 home loss last night to the Kelowna Rockets, who took a 3-1 lead early in the second and added a power play marker midway through the third to pull away. Both of Vancouver's goals last night came on the power play, so they will look to generate more at 5-on-5 today. Despite the loss, the Giants are still 5-2-0-1 in their last eight games. The Cougars have had a strong start, winning seven of their first nine games, though they are now 2-3-0 in their last five games. Prince George has played twice already this weekend: losing 6-2 to Portland on Friday before rebounding with a 4-3 OT win last night in Seattle. The Cougars are an impressive 5-1-0 on the road so far this season. With the addition of Penticton to the B.C. division, the Giants and Cougars will only play four times this season, down from eight last year.

LAST TIME OUT

The Vancouver Giants were defeated 5-2 by the visiting Kelowna Rockets on Saturday night at Langley Events Centre. Ethan Mittelsteadt and Aaron Obobaifo scored the Giants goals, both of which came on the power play. Vancouver found themselves down 3-1 entering the third period and pushed hard to tie the game, firing 19 shots on goal, but 4-2 was as close as they'd get. Kelowna goaltender Josh Banini finished the night with 31 saves on 33 shots.

NOTEWORTHY

SCHMIDTY RED HOT

Giants forward **Cameron Schmidt** sits 6th in WHL scoring entering Sunday's action with 23 points (10G-13A). Schmidt's seven-game point streak (8G-6A) came to an end on Nov. 1, as did his five-game goal streak.

LIN LEADING THE WAY

Draft-eligible defenceman **Ryan Lin** is having an incredible start to the year with 20 points (3G-17A) through the first 16 games, leading all d-man in the WHL in scoring. The right-shot blueliner put up 53 points in 60 games last year, becoming the first WHL defenceman – along with Landon Dupont – to reach the 50-point milestone in his 16-year-old season since Scott Niedermayer in 1990. Lin was the first WHL player named to team CHL for November's CHL USA Prospects Challenge. Lin was ranked **7th** on TSN's Pre-Season NHL Draft ranking, consisting of a survey of 10 NHL scouts.

HOOD HONOURED AS GOALIE OF WEEK

Giants goaltender **Burke Hood** was named the WHL Goaltender of the Week on Monday, Oct. 20, after he went 2-0-0-0 with a 1.50 G.A.A and .955 SV%, stopping 64 of 67 shots thrown his way in the two wins. The 18-year-old New York Islanders draft pick was named the second star of the night in a 5-2 Giants win over Wenatchee on Friday and the first star after he made 29 saves on 30 shots in a 3-1 win over Medicine Hat.

CALL FOR CANADA

Giants forward **Blake Chorney** is currently representing Canada at the 2025 U17 World Challenge in Nova Scotia, which takes place Nov. 2-8. The left-shot centre is suiting up for Canada Red, as Canada sends 44 players in total split into two teams. The 16-year-old has not shown his youth early on in his rookie season, chipping in four goals and seven points in 15 games.

BURD-MAN BURYING THE BISCUIT

Vancouver Giants 5th-year forward **Ty Halaburda** has scored nine goals already this season in his first 16 games. Five of the nine have come on the power play. Halaburda now has 85 career goals, all with Vancouver, which ranks 9th in franchise history, one behind Craig Cunningham.

SOLIDIFYING THE NET

On Oct. 16, the Giants acquired 20-year-old netminder **Kelton Pyne** from the Regina Pats in exchange for a 6th-round pick in 2028. Pyne was the Pats Player of the Year last season, after he posted an .887 save percentage, 3.56 goals-against average and 13-22-4-3 record for a team that only won 16 games all season. He was lights out in his first ever start for the Giants on Oct. 18, stopping 40 of 43 shots in a 4-3 SO loss to the Penticton Vees. He has played in 105 career WHL games.

NEW BRASS

Leading the Giants this season behind the bench will be an almost entirely new staff: **Head Coach Parker Burgess** joins from the USHL – where he won a Clark Cup Championship with Muskegon; Assistant Coach **Wacey Rabbit** joins from the Saskatoon Blades; and Assistant Coach **Gaelan Patterson** joins from the Nanaimo Clippers. Video and Skill Development Coach Kayden Jarvis returns for his third season. Putting all the pieces together is new General Manager **Hnat Domenichelli**, who won back-to-back Memorial Cups as a player in the 1990s with the Kamloops Blazers before a seven-year NHL career and 11-year pro career in Switzerland. Domenichelli was most recently the GM of the professional team in Lugano in the NLA from 2019-25.

CALL TO NHL ROOKIE CAMPS

Six Giants eligible to play for the club in the 2025-26 season were invited to NHL rookie camps: **Colton Alain** (Calgary), **Burke Hood** (New York Islanders), **Aaron Obobaifo** (VAN), **Jakob Oreskovic** (VAN), **Cameron Schmidt** (Dallas) and **Tyler Thorpe** (Montreal, still in the AHL).

DRAFT SZN

It's going to be a massive year for Richmond native **Ryan Lin**, who has a lot of hype surrounding him as one of the top defencemen available for the 2026 NHL Draft. He and exceptional status defenceman Landon Dupont (eligible in 2027) broke a 35-year old record last season for points by a 16-year-old rookie defenceman, with them each eclipsing 50. It's also the first year of NHL Draft eligibility for **Tobias Tomik**, **Tyus Sparks**, **Brett Olson**, goaltender **Owen Lunneborg** and rookies **Luca Pura** and **Braydon Riggall**.

PRESEASON WRAP

The Giants went a perfect 4-0 in the 2025 preseason. Their first two games were on the road: they beat Kamloops on Sept. 3 by a 3-1 score and they beat Penticton on Sept. 4 by a 4-3 score. Following that, the Giants beat Victoria twice at 'home': 7-4 in Ladner on Sept. 9 and 3-2 in OT in Port Coquitlam on Sept. 10. Notable preseason performances included **Tyus Sparks**, who exploded for seven goals and nine points in three games, and **Tobias Tomik**, who had a hat-trick against Penticton on Sept. 4.

NEWS AND NOTES

THRU 14: The Prince George Cougars enter tonight's contest with an 9-5-0-0 record through their first 14 games in the 2025-26 season. 112 of the 14 meetings have come against US Division opponents. Tonight marks the second time this season the Cougars will face a BC Division opponent. The team is coming off a come-from-behind 4-3 OT win over the Seattle Thunderbirds last night. Bauer Dumanski scored the overtime winner. Kayden Lemire, Dmitri Yakutsenak, and Carson Carels also supplied goals in the win.

CARELS TO TEAM CHL: On Tuesday, October 28th, defenceman Carson Carels was named to Team CHL for the CHL/USA Top Prospects Game in Lethbridge, AB. This marks the third straight season the Cougars have put a player into the Team CHL Top Prospect's Game.

NEW GUYS ARE COOKIN: Cougars forwards Kooper Gizowski and Brock Souch are off to tremendous starts this season. Gizowski leads all Cougars in scoring thus far this season with 24 points (11-13-24) in his first 14 and has points in every game so far this season. For Souch, he owns 19 points, and has collected points in 13 of 14 games.

HISTORY MADE: On Saturday, October 18th, the Cougars set a new franchise record in their 9-3 win over Tri-City. The Cats scored four goals in a span of 67 seconds, marking the quickest four goals ever scored in franchise history. The WHL's record for fastest four goals came in 1979 when the Lethbridge Broncos scored four in 52 seconds.

NHL CENTRAL SCOUTING: Four Prince George Cougars were named to the National Hockey League's Central Scouting Preliminary Rankings ahead of the 2026 NHL Draft. Carson Carels highlights the quartet after being named an 'A'-rated player, indicating him as a first-round candidate. Kayden Lemire and Dermot Johnston both received 'C' rankings, indicating them as 4th/5th-round candidates. Phoenix Cahill rounds out the four as a 'W'-ranked skater, indicating him as a 6th/7th-round candidate.

THE BERGER: After collecting his seventh career shutout against Seattle on October 17th, **Josh Ravensbergen** ranks tied for third in franchise history in that statistic. He is now tied with Justin Pogge, Ty Edmonds, and Tyler Brennan. Real Cyr is the leader with 14. That shutout by Ravensbergen was his first since December 9/23.

CAPTAIN DUMANSKI: On Thursday, October 2nd, the Cougars named **Bauer Dumanski** the 31st captain in Prince George Cougars history. Dumanski succeeds Riley Heidt who captained the club in 2024-25. Dumanski is a fifth year blue-liner and has already surpassed the 250 games played mark in the WHL. Supporting Dumanski in his new role are **Carson Carels, Terik Parascak, and Corbin Vaughan**.

2024-25 SEASON RECAP: The Prince George Cougars wrapped up the 2024-25 campaign with a 41-21-4-2 record (88 points), securing second place in the BC Division and fourth overall in the Western Conference. On home ice, the Cougars were a force, posting the best record in the BC Division and tying for the top mark in the Western Conference with a dominant 24-5-3-2 (53 points), matching the Everett Silvertips. In the 2025 WHL Playoffs, Prince George battled the Portland Winterhawks in a thrilling seven-game opening-round series. Washington Capitals prospect **Terik Parascak** led all returning Cougars in scoring with 28 goals and 54 assists in 59 games. Meanwhile, San Jose Sharks first-round pick **Josh Ravensbergen** delivered an outstanding season in goal, recording 33 wins — the second-most in the WHL.

DRAFTED: Two Cougars were selected at the 2025 NHL Draft in Los Angeles, CA. **Josh Ravensbergen** was chosen in the first round, 30th overall, by the San Jose Sharks. With the pick, he became both the highest-drafted goaltender in Cougars history and the highest-drafted goalie in Sharks history. **Aiden Foster** was then taken by the Tampa Bay Lightning in the fifth round, 127th overall. Foster is the first Cougar selected by Tampa Bay since Brett Connolly in 2010.

LETS GO CAMPING! Four Prince George Cougars were invited to NHL Rookie Camps this September. Forwards **Aiden Foster** (Tampa Bay Lightning), **Terik Parascak** (Washington Capitals), defenceman **Corbin Vaughan** (New York Rangers), and goaltender **Joshua Ravensbergen** (San Jose Sharks). For Foster, he found the back of the net and suited up in two games for the bolts, Ravensbergen picked up a win in his first start in an NHL jersey, and Vaughan dropped the mitts twice in the same game. For Parascak, he also got into games and provided a pair of assists. All four Cougars have now returned to the team and are back for the remainder of the season.

O CANADA: Both Joshua Ravensbergen and Terik Parascak attended Team Canada's National Junior Summer Showcase this summer which took place in Minneapolis, MN. The camp serves as an evaluation for Hockey Canada to select its roster to compete in the 2026 IIHF World Junior Hockey Championship in December. Ravensbergen and Parascak were two of 40 players invited to this summer's camp.

CARSON CANADA: Carson Carels was selected to represent Team Canada the Hlinka-Gretzky Cup this past August in Trencin, SVK and Brno, CZE. Carson and the Canadians earned a bronze medal, defeating Finland in their final game by a 3-0 score. This marks the third time Carels had earned the opportunity to represent the maple leaf. The 17-year-old draft eligible blue-liner owned a nice rookie season for the Cats, contributing, 38 points, and impressive +22 plus/minus which ranked in the Top WHL rookie skaters. Carels was originally selected 16th overall by Prince George in the 2023 WHL Prospects Draft.
