BY THE NUMBERS

TIGHT WEEKEND IN VICTORIA... The Winterhawks battled back from a two-goal deficit on Saturday night and nearly completed the comeback, but ultimately fell on goal short in a 4-3 decision. The Royals got goals from Brandon Lisowsky, Hayden Moore, Reggie Newman, and Teydon Trembecky, while Diego Buttazzoni was the star for Portland with two goals and an assist. Buttazzoni scored Portland's first two goals of the games to bring the Hawks within one with over half of the third period to go. Victoria scored in the final two minutes to go up 4-2 and Ryan Miller answered back for the team's second power play goal to make it 4-3. Despite a strong push the extra attacker, the Hawks lost their second straight game on Vancouver Island.

LAST SEASON RECAP... Portland finished the regular season as U.S. Division Champions with 48 wins, finishing second in the Western Conference, one point behind the Prince George Cougars. It represented the 15th time the Winterhawks have won a regular season division title (6th U.S. & 9 West Division titles) and first time since the 2019-20 season. Recent WHL graduates Gabe Klassen, Jack O'Brien, and James Stefan each won the division twice during their tenure. The Winterhawks led the Western Conference with 27 home ice victories and led the entire WHL with 330 total goals.

Portland won at least 40 regular season for its seventh straight season. It's the longest active streak of 40+ wins in the Canadian Hockey League (next closest CHL team has two consecutive). This was also the 13th consecutive season the Winterhawks competed for the Ed Chynoweth Cup and 13th time they played in the championship series. Portland beat Victoria, Everett, and Prince George in the 2024 WHL Playoffs en route to the WHL Championship Series. The Hawks made their first finals appearance since 2014, however were swept 4-0 in the series against Moose Jaw.



WESTERN HOCKEY LEAGUE PLAYERS TO WATCH

#19 | KYLE CHYZOWSKI

The Winterhawks captain leads all Winterhawks with six points in three meetings against the Blazers. Chyzowski is fourth in the WHL with 39 goals and 96 points. He tallied his 32nd multipoint game Saturday night in Victoria and enters the night with points in five straight contests. The Surrey, B.C. native has 222 points in 265 career games, all with the Winterhawks, and is committed to the University of Denver next year.

#9 | EMMITT FINNIE

Smashing a career high in goals and points, the Detroit Red Wings prospect has goals in three of his last four games, including a goal and an assist in Seattle last night. After missing three weeks with a injury the team's captain returned to the ice by scoring a pair of goals, including the game winner, last Wednesday night against the Hawks.

NEWS AND NOTES

CHYZOWSKI CHOOSES DENVER... The Winterhawks are proud to share that captain Kyle Chyzowski has committed to the University of Denver for the 2025-26 season following his WHL career.

At the time of his commitment, Chyzowski leads the Winterhawks and ranks fifth in the Western Hockey League with 37 goals and 90 points in 55 games. With a month to go in the regular season, Chyzowski has already shattered new career highs in scoring, nearly doubling his point production from his 19-year-old campaign. He surpassed 250 career WHL games played in January and was recognized on the Canadian Hockey League Team of the Month for December after scoring a CHL-leading ten goals in the final month of 2024. The Surrey, B.C. native has 216 career points (86G, 130A) in 262 regular-season games to date. Chyzowski has been an anchor all season on the team's top power play and penalty kill units and the fifth-year Winterhawk ranks third in the league with four shorthanded goals. He led the Winterhawks with nine WHL playoff goals during the their 2024 Western Conference Championship run. At the beginning of this season, Chyzowski was named the 49th captain in Portland Winterhawks history. Chyzowski was originally selected by Portland in the third round of the 2019 WHL Prospects Draft.

THOMPSON COMMITS TO MIAMI UNIVERSITY... The Portland Winterhawks are proud to share that defenseman and alternate captain Ryder Thompson has committed to Miami University (Ohio) following his WHL career. Thompson, 20, is set to join the RedHawks ahead of the 2025-26 season and he plans to study business.

At the time of his commitment, Thompson has produced 77 points (12G, 65A) in 244 career WHL games, all with the Winterhawks. With just under two months left in the regular season, Thompson has already set new career highs in goals (7) and shots on goal (80). He has a strong chance of surpassing 250 career WHL games and will

become just the 11th Winterhawks defenseman all-time to achieve that milestone with the club. Thompson currently helps run the team's second power play unit, is a leader on the Hawks' penalty kill, and is often relied on by his coaches to match up against the opposing team's top line.

The Russell, Man. native is serving as an alternate captain for his second season in Portland and he helped guide the Winterhawks to a 2024 Western Conference Championship. He ranked sixth on last year's team with a plus-35 rating and registered a career-best 21 assists. Thompson was the 2023 and 2024 Winterhawk Award recipient, which is given annually to the player who embodies character, leadership, and heart and soul. Thompson was originally selected by the Winterhawks in the fifth round of the 2019 WHL Prospects Draft.

FOUR HAWKS ON CENTRAL SCOUTING... Winterhawks goaltender Ondřej Štěbeták, forwards Ryan Miller and Diego Buttazzoni, and defenseman Max Pšenička have all been recognized on NHL Central Scouting's midseason rankings for the 2025 NHL Draft.

Czech netminder Ondřej Štěbeták clocks in as the No.6 ranked goaltender in North America. Selected by Portland in the first round of the 2024 WHL Import Draft, Štěbeták has established himself as one of the top netminders in North America. At the time of the rankings, he has recorded 14 wins this season, a 3.90 goals-against average, as well as a WHL Rookie of the Week nod from the league earlier this season. Štěbeták has allowed two or fewer goals in three starts since December 1, 2024. Ryan Miller comes in as the No.118 North American skater. The Medicine Hat, Alberta native wears an 'A' as an alternate captain for the Hawks in his second season. Through 22 games, he has recorded 16 points (8G, 8A). Diego Buttazzoni, in his second NHL Draft eligible season, checks in at No. 191 among North American skaters. The forward from Burnaby, B.C. has been a consistent force for Portland this season, posting 49 points (22G, 27A) in 37 games at the time of the midseason rankings. Finally, Max Pšenička was named the No. 8 international skater for the upcoming draft. The 6-foot-4, 178-pound blueliner from Prague, Czechia, was acquired by the Winterhawks in October and signed a WHL Scholarship & Development Agreement with Portland on January 10. Pšenička has showcased his skills on both domestic and international stages, tallying 11 points (3G, 8A) in 16 games with HC Plzeň U20 and adding two goals in 16 Czech Extraliga contests. He also represented Czechia at the U18 level, contributing six points (2G, 4A) in 10 games. Pšenička received a 'C' rating in NHL Central Scouting's preliminary rankings last fall.

BEST DRESSED... Winterhawks alternate captain Ryder Thompson skated in his 250th career WHL regular-season game on February 21 in Everett and he even scored in the milestone game. He became the 11th Winterhawks defenseman all-time to lace up in 250+ games, most recently 2021-22 captain Clay Hanus. Originally selected by the Winterhawks in the fifth round of the 2015 WHL Prospects Draft, Thompson has more than doubled his goal scoring production with eight goals this year. He is a two-time recipient of the Winterhawk Award, given annually to the Winterhawk who embodies character, leadership, heart and soul.

MR. 200... Winterhawks captain Kyle Chyzowski notched three assists in the January 24 win against Tri-City to propel him to 201 career regular-season points and counting. He became just the 38th Winterhawk all-time to achieve that milestone, following in the footsteps of last year's leaders Gabe Klassen and James Stefan. If he can crack a 100+ point season, Chyzowski will enter the Winterhawks' top 30 all-time scorers. For family comparisons, his cousin Ryan produced 217 career WHL points and his other cousin Nick netted 134 points, his uncle Dave had 144 WHL points and his other under Ron plus his dad Barry played NCAA hockey.

HAWKS STRIKE A DEADLINE DEAL... In the final minutes leading up to the WHL's Trade Deadline, the Portland Winterhawks acquired 2007-born forward Lochlan Tetarenko from the Saskatoon Blades in exchange for a conditional pick in the 2026 WHL Prospects Draft. Tetarenko, 17, has produced five assists in 25 games during his rookie season with the Blades. The Houston, Texas native recently won a Canadian Sport School Hockey League (CSSHL) Championship with Edge School last season. Tetarenko netted eight goals and 18 assists for 26 points in 30 games with Edge School's Under-18 prep team. On the international stage, he represented Team Alberta at the 2023 Canada Winter Games alongside Winterhawks alternate captain Ryan Miller. The 5-foot-10 forward also played with current Winterhawks forward Kyle McDonough from 2021 to 2023 with the Okotoks Oilers program. Tetarenko scored 75 combined points (36G, 39A) across 71 games with the Oilers under-18 and under-15 teams and he ranked second on his team in scoring behind McDonough with 50 points during his WHL Draft year. Tetarenko was originally selected by Saskatoon in the third round of the 2022 WHL Prospects Draft. Lochlan's father, Joey Tetarenko, played four years in Portland from 1994 to 1998 and was Team Captain during the Winterhawks 1998 Memorial Cup Championship. Joey produced 56 points and tallied 654 penalty minutes in 247 career regular-season WHL games. When Lochlan made his Winterhawks debut on January 15, he and his dad became the fifth father son duo to play in Portland (Oren and Miles Koules, Darrell May Sr. and Darrell May Jr., Dave and Joe Morrow, and Gord and Luke Walker).

CZECHING IN... The day following the WHL's Trade Deadline, the Winterhawks announce that defenseman Max Pšenička has signed a WHL Scholarship & Development Agreement with the club. Pšenička, 17, was originally selected by the Kelowna Rockets in the first round (32nd overall) of the 2024 CHL Import Draft before Portland acquired his WHL rights in October. This season, the Prague, Czechia native has split time between HC Plzeň U20 and their top club in the Czech Extraliga. With the U20 team, he tallied 11 points (3G, 8A) in 16 games, while also contributing two goals in 16 Extraliga contests. On the international stage, he represented Czechia with the U18 national team, posting six points (2G, 4A) in 10 games during the 2024-25 campaign. Before joining Plzeň, the 6-foot-4, 178-pound blueliner spent time with HC Slavia Praha's U17 and U20 programs, amassing 50 points (13G, 37A) in 70 U17 games. Pšenička is eligible for the 2025 NHL draft and was named to the NHL Central Scouting's Preliminary Players to Watch list as a C-rated prospect.

JUGNAUTH COMMITS TO MICHIGAN ST... Winterhawks alternate captain Tyson Jugnauth announced on December 30th that he has committed to play NCAA hockey for Michigan State University following his WHL career. Drafted in the fourth round, 100th overall, by the Seattle Kraken in the 2022 NHL Draft, Jugnauth is also eligible to begin his professional career in the 2025-26 season.

Jugnauth has been a standout player for the Winterhawks since joining the club during the 2023-24 campaign. At the time of his commitment, Jugnauth had played 73 games, amassing 13 goals and 73 assists for 86 points. This season, the blue liner has tallied 45 points (6G, 39A) in 34 games. He ranks second in the Canadian Hockey League (CHL) in assists and leads all WHL defensemen in points. Since joining the Winterhawks in December 2023, Jugnauth has consistently showcased his skill, helping the team capture the Western Conference Championship in his first year. During the Winterhawks' run to the WHL Championship Series, Jugnauth ranked third on the team with 16 points (4G, 12A) in 18 postseason contests.

JUGNAUTH MAKES HISTORY... Tyson Jugnauth totaled six assists in the Winterhawks 7-2 win against Vancouver on December 7. He is the first Winterhawk to produce six points in a game since Oliver Bjorkstrand (3G-3A) did so on January 31, 2015. He is the first Winterhawk since Troy Mick (7A) on November 23, 1988 to produce six assists in a single game and sixth Winterhawks to do it all-time (Mick, Ken Yaremchuk x2, Jim Dobson, Ed Cooper, and Brent Peterson). Jugnauth is also the second WHL defenseman since 1996-97 to contribute six helpers in a single game, joining former Moose Jaw Warriors defenseman Denton Mateychuk from his feat in 2022. The day following this impressive accomplishment, Jugnauth tallied the primary assist on the Teddy Bear Toss goal. After his impressive home weekend, Jugnauth was named the WHL Player of the Week for the week ending on December 9, 2024. It represented the first time Jugnauth has captured the WHL's weekly honors. Fast forward to January 1 and the Kelowna, B.C. product had 20 assists in a 10 game stretch. The closest to that production for the team in the Internet era is Nick Petan with 19 assists in 10 games during the 2013-14 seasons.

PLANTE LANDS IN PORTLAND... The Winterhawks added 19-year-old forward and University of Nebraska-Omaha commit Joel Plante to the roster ahead of the December 13 weekend. Originally added to the Hawks protected list in December, Plante signed his WHL Scholarship & Development Agreement with the Winterhawks after producing 27 points in 25 games with the Nanaimo Clippers of the BCHL. Plante led the Clippers in scoring with 12 goals prior to signing with Portland. Spending the last four years in the BCHL (Nanaimo and Surrey), Plante has amassed 79 points in 172 career junior games. The Langley, B.C. product previously developed with Yale Hockey Academy, playing with a handful of soon-to-be WHL players.

WELCOMING WEIERMAIR... University of Denver forward Alex Weiermair signed a WHL Scholarship & Development Agreement with Portland prior to the team's Teddy Bear Toss weekend. Weiermair, 19, was originally selected by the Winterhawks with the 16th overall pick in the 2020 WHL U.S. Priority Draft. He has remained on the club's protected college list after originally electing to play NCAA hockey. Weiermair played two seasons with the United States National Team Development Program (USNTDP) before enrolling at the University of Denver in the fall of 2023. The Los Angeles, CA native recorded 49 points in 107 combined games with the USNTDP under-17 and under-18 teams and won a world under-18 championship with Team USA before joining the Pioneers. The 6-foot-1, 202-pound forward appeared in 33 games for the University of Denver across two seasons, securing eight points. He was also a part of Denver's 2024 National Championship as a freshman.

CAPT. CHYZ... Kyle Chyzowski, a fifth-year Winterhawk, was named the club's 49th captain in team history ahead of Portland's home opener. The 20-year-old from Surrey, B.C. has scored over 50 goals in 200+ career WHL regular season games. After wearing an "A" the last two seasons, Chyzowski now follows in the footsteps of his cousins Nick and Ryan who were also captains during their playing days in the WHL. Nick was the Kamloops Blazers captain during the 2017-18 season and Ryan captained the Medicine Hat Tigers during the 2019-20 campaign.

MILESTONES

Jordan Duguay scored his first career WHL goal in the Hawks season opener in Kamloops on September 20. **Carsyn Dyck** and **Reed Brown** each netted their first career WHL goal on Saturday, September 21 in Kelowna. Alternate captain **Ryder Thompson** laced up in his 200th career regular-season game during the Hawks' home opener on October 4. **Marek Schlenker** made his WHL debut against Prince George on October 5, stopping 38 of 40 shots to secure his first win as a Hawk. **David Hoy**, a product of Fort St. James, B.C. just over an hour and a half north of Prince George, scored his first WHL points thanks to his primary assist on October 8 in Prince George. He netted his first WHL goal later that month in an October 26th home game against Edmonton. **Kyle Chyzowski** secured his 150th career WHL points on November 9 in Wenatchee. He recorded four points in the win, including a shorthanded goal to reach the milestone. **Josh Zakreski** netted his first career hat trick on November 29 and also surpassed 100 career points in the same game. **Diego Buttazzoni** scored twice against Vancouver on December 7. His first goal (the eventual game-winning goal) of the night was his 100th career point in the WHL. **Alex Weiermair** made his WHL debut on December 7 and scored his first WHL goal, assist, and multipoint game in the effort. **Joel Plante** made his Winterhawks debut on December 13 against the Prince George Cougars and he recorded his first career point via an assist the next night on December 14 against Seattle. With an assist on December 17, **Kyle Chyzowski** surpassed 100 career assists with the Winterhawks.

Joel Plante scored his first WHL goal, the eventual game-winning goal, on January 2 against Spokane. **Lochlan Tetarenko** made his Winterhawks debut on January 15 against his former club in Saskatoon. **Kyle Chyzowski** dressed in his 250th career WHL game on January 17 in Moose Jaw, becoming the 36th Winterhawk all-time to reach 250 WHL games. In that same game, **Tyson Jugnauth** secured two assists to bring his career point totals up to 100. **Max Pšenička** skated in his first career WHL game on January 24 against Tri-City, registering an assist in the win. **Kyle Chyzowski** recorded his 200th career point in that same game thanks to a three assist performance. **Hudson Darby** laced up in his 100th career WHL game on February 8 against Seattle. **Ryder Thompson** skated in his 250th career WHL game and **Kyle McDonough** is dressed in his 100th on February 21 in Everett. **Josh Zakreski** played in his 200th career WHL game on February 23. Seattle Kraken prospect **Tyson Jugnauth** recorded his 100th career assist on February 26 in Kamloops.



Chyzowski is joined by Ryder Thompson, Tyson Jugnauth, Carter Sotheran, Josh Zakreski, and Ryan Miller on the leadership group, who will all serve as alternate captains this season. Ryder Thompson will be an alternate captain for all 68 games and the other four will rotate captaincy between home and away games.

SILVER FOR ŠTĚBETÁK... Ondřej Štěbeták, the Winterhawks first-round selection (#57 overall) in the 2024 CHL Import Draft, captured a silver medal with Czechia at the 2024 Hlinka-Gretzky Cup. Štěbeták allowed just five goals in four tournament games, with his lone loss coming at the hands of the Canadians. He ranked second among goaltenders who appeared in at least two games with a .947 save percentage and 1.27 goals-against average. The native of Jihlava, Czech Republic comes to Portland after spending the last three seasons with his hometown HC Dukla Jihlava program. He is a top goaltending prospect for the 2025 NHL Draft.

HAWKS FLY TO NHL CAMPS... The Portland Winterhawks hockey club is proud to recognize 12 players from the 2024 Western Conference Championship team who have been invited to NHL training camps in September. Nine of the 12 players are eligible to play for the Winterhawks during the 2024-25 season.

Marek Alscher (Florida), Luca Cagnoni (San Jose), Kyle Chyzowski (Tampa Bay), Nate Danielson (Detroit), Josh Davies (Florida), Tyson Jugnauth (Seattle), Gabe Klassen (Pittsburgh), Marcus Nguyen (Florida), Carter Sotheran (Philadelphia), Jan Špunar (Florida), James Stefan (Edmonton), and Josh Zakreski (Philadelphia) all earned invited to NHL rookie camps.

GUSTAFSON PROMOTED, HOCKEY OPERATIONS CHANGES... Earlier this summer, the Portland Winterhawks announced Mike Johnston had signed a four-year extension to continue as President & General Manager of the Winterhawks. Johnston will increase his focus on the development aspects of Winterhawks players and prospects. In conjunction with his extension, longtime assistant coach Kyle Gustafson will become the eighth head coach in Winterhawks franchise history.

Johnston has spent 13 years as the Winterhawks' head coach, becoming only the 11th coach in Western Hockey League history to surpass 500 wins while amassing one of the highest overall winning percentages with an overall WHL coaching record of 544-249-33-31. Under Johnston's leadership, the Winterhawks have become one of the best programs in amateur hockey for developing players on and off the ice, evident by the five WHL Finals appearances, including a championship in 2013. The Winterhawks President & General Manager also assisted 46 Winterhawks players to sign NHL contracts and countless members of his hockey operations staff have moved on to similar positions in the NHL. Last season, he was named the U.S. Division Coach of the Year and U.S. Division Executive of the Year. The Dartmouth, Nova Scotia native served as an assistant coach for Hockey Canada at the 2025 IIHF World Junior Championship, which took place in Ottawa, Ontario from December 26, 2024 to January 5, 2025. Johnston previously served as an assistant coach for the under-20 team in 1994, 1995, and 1996.

After working as an assistant coach of Winterhawks for 20 of the last 21 seasons, Gustafson assumes the position of head coach beginning with the 2024-25 season. The Portland native served as the team's assistant coach from 2003 to 2016 before getting promoted to associate coach ahead of the 2017-18 season. The 43-year-old has also held the title of Assistant General Manager since the 2018-19 season. Gustafson also worked as an assistant coach of the Vancouver Canucks during the 2021-22 season before returning to Portland in the fall of 2022. He previously earned his first win operating as the Winterhawks head coach on January 17, 2020 in a 5-3 defeat of the Spokane Chiefs.

TOP ASSISTANTS... After the promotion of Kyle Gustafson to head coach, Portland filled its bench staff by hiring Mike Fanelli and former Winterhawk star Sven Bärtschi to serve as assistant coaches.

Fanelli, 29, brings a wealth of NHL experience to Portland. He recently served as the Edmonton Oilers Video & Coaching Analytics Coordinator during the 2023-24 season and won two Stanley Cup championships while working for the Tampa Bay Lightning in its analytics department from 2017 to 2021. The Jacksonville, Florida native spent two years as an assistant coach of the United States Hockey League's (USHL) Sioux City Musketeers from 2021-2023. He helped coach the Musketeers to a Clark Cup Championship during the 2021-22 campaign. Fanelli played college hockey at the University of South Florida from 2012-17 and served as the program's associate coach from 2018-20.

Bärtschi, 31, joins the Winterhawks coaching staff after enjoying 11 years of professional hockey and two memorable years as a WHL player in the Rose City. The Bern, Switzerland native most recently skated for his hometown SC Bern during the 2022-23 season. Before his one-year stint overseas, Bärtschi dressed in over 500 combined NHL/AHL games from 2012 to 2022 with the Calgary Flames, Vancouver Canucks, and Vegas Golden Knights organizations. While playing in Portland for Mike Johnston and Kyle Gustafson, Bärtschi helped lead the Winterhawks to back-to-back WHL Finals appearances in 2011 and 2012. He served as the club's alternate captain during the 2011-12 campaign and ranked second on the team with 94 points in just 47 games. Bärtschi was recognized as a WHL Western Conference Second Team All-Star in 2012 and he led the Hawks in playoff scoring with 34 points in 22 postseason contests.
