BY THE NUMBERS

GAME 7 ROAD WIN... The Portland Winterhawks captured their second, road Game 7 victory during the 2025 WHL Playoffs, presented by Nutrien. The Silvertips scored the game's opening goal in the deciding Tuesday game, but Kyle Chyzowski netted his series-leading seventh goal of the round inside a minute to play in the second period to take a 1-1 game to the final intermission. Lukas Kaplan gave Everett a lead on a wrist shot off the rush just over three minutes into the third period, but the Winterhawks responded with goals from Hudson Darby and Kyle McDonough 30 seconds apart to give Portland a 3-2 lead at Angel of the Winds Arena. In the final moments, Everett committed a penalty for too many men on the ice and Diego Buttazzoni scored into the empty net to give the Hawks a 4-2 win, advancing them to the Western Conference Championship Series for the second straight season. Ondřej Štěbeták was spectacular in net, turning aside 40 shots for his fourth time in the series.

REGULAR SEASON RECAP... Portland finished the regular season in third place in the U.S. Division with 36 wins. The Winterhawks boasted a 13-6-2-0 overall record against B.C. Division opponents and a .500 record against U.S. Division foes. Led by captain Kyle Chyzowski and his 105 points (4th highest in WHL, 9th highest in CHL), the Winterhawks were one of three WHL clubs - Spokane and Medicine Hat - to produce three 35+ goal scorers. Josh Zakreski finished the regular season with a career-high 39 goals and Diego Buttazzoni cashed in with 38 in his third WHL season.

This is the 14th consecutive season the Winterhawks will compete for the Ed Chynoweth Cup. Portland beat Victoria, Everett, and Prince George in the 2024 WHL Playoffs en route to the WHL Championship Series, including rattling off eight consecutive wins in the postseason for the first time in franchise history. The Hawks made their first finals appearance since 2014, however were swept 4-0 in the series against Moose Jaw.



WESTERN HOCKEY LEAGUE PLAYERS TO WATCH

#19 | KYLE CHYZOWSKI

The Winterhawks' captain scored his first career WHL playoff hat trick, and fourth overall as a Hawk, in the second round against Everett. He enters tonight's Game 1 tied for fourth in playoff points (25) and has a six-game point streak. The Surrey, B.C. native led the Hawks with five goals in six regular-season contests against Spokane.

#82 | ANDREW CRISTALL

Tied for first in WHL Playoff scoring with 28, Cristall has produced a point in all 11 playoff contests with the Chiefs. He scored the game-winning goal in overtime in both Game 5 and Game 6 against Victoria and has multiple points in four straight games, with goals in all four. His 132 regular-season points were the most in the WHL.

NEWS AND NOTES

GAME 7 HISTORY... Tuesday night in Everett represented the club's 17th Game 7 in playoff history and the Hawks are now 8-9 in those deciding games and 2-0 in Game 7s this month. Prior to the 2025 playoffs, the most recent situation was in 2022 where the Hawks led 3-1 and proceeded to lose three straight, including Game 7 on home ice, against Seattle. The Hawks beat Spokane in the opening round of the 2018 WHL Playoffs in seven games. This April was the first time since the 2012 WHL Finals that the Hawks played a Game 7 on the road.

SEASONED VETERANS... Not enough can be said about the leadership of captain Kyle Chyzowski, alternate captain Ryder Thompson, and alternate captain Tyson Jugnauth. All three 20-year-old skaters are enjoying impressive playoff success. Chyzowski and Thompson dressed in their 50th career playoff games in Game 5 of the Western Conference Semifinals, becoming the 20th and 21st Winterhawks all-time to reach that achievement. Kyle Chyzowski scored in that same game to reach 20 career playoff goals. He is the 18th Winterhawks to hit that total and is currently 14th all-time in career playoff points (50). He recently surpassed notable alumni Glen Wesley, Ryan Johansen, Troy Rutkowski, and Nino Niederreiter in career postseason points. Jugnauth has 42 career playoff points, which puts him fourth all-time among defensemen in franchise history. Only Troy Rutkowski, Glen Wesley, and Derrick Pouliot have more than the Seattle Kraken prospect.

APPROACHING A FRANCHISE MILESTONE... Alternate captain Josh Zakreski is expected to dress in his 47th career WHL playoff game tonight (Game 1 at Spokane). He has a chance to join two of his leaders and become the 22nd Winterhawk all-time to achieve 50 or more playoff games. For context, 12 players on the Winterhawks active roster entered the 2025 playoffs having never played in a WHL postseason game. Nine of those players made their WHL playoff debut during the opening round and another two made their debuts in round two.

PLAYOFF HISTORY BETWEEN PORTLAND AND SPOKANE.... This will be the 13th ever meeting between Portland and Spokane in the WHL Playoffs, and first since 2019. As expected, nobody was on roster the last time the two sides met in the postseason because 2019 was the draft class that produced Kyle Chyzowski (3rd round), Ryder Thompson (5th round), and Shea Van Olm (Edmonton, 6th round).

REGULAR-SEASON SERIES... The Winterhawks won two of the six meetings against the Chiefs during the regular season, both on home ice while Berkly Catton was away at World Juniors and before the addition of Andrew Cristall. Kyle Chyzowski paced all Winterhawks with ten points (5G, 5A), followed closely behind by Alex Weiermair's four goals in three meetings against the Chiefs. Shea Van Olm (7G, 7A) led the way for Spokane with 14 points and Cristall and Berkly Catton round out the players to surpass ten points head-to-head. Portland surrendered at least one power play goal in all six meetings. Goaltender Ondřej Štěbeták secured two wins against Spokane and flaunted an impressive .920 save percentage in four starts against the division foe.

FOUR HAWKS ON CENTRAL SCOUTING... Winterhawks goaltender Ondřej Štěbeták, forwards Ryan Miller and Diego Buttazzoni, and defenseman Max Pšenička have all been recognized on NHL Central Scouting's final rankings for the 2025 NHL Draft.

Czech netminder **Ondřej Štěbeták** clocks in as the No.8 ranked goaltender in North America. Selected by Portland in the first round of the 2024 WHL Import Draft, Štěbeták finished the WHL regular season with a rookie-high 23 wins in 47 games played and he turned aside 89.1% of the shots he faced. On November 11, 2023, he was recognized by the WHL as the Rookie of the Week. Standing 6-foot-1, Štěbeták stopped 33-of-35 shots in Game 7 in the Western Conference Quarterfinal and 118-of-126 shots (93.7%) in the first three contests of the second round. Fellow countryman **Max Pšenička** earned the highest rating of North American skaters, ending the season ranked 40th. In 2024-2025, the 6-foot-4, 178-pound blueliner from Prague, Czechia, has points in the Czech Extraliga, with the Czechia National Team at the U18 level, HC Plzeň U20, and one goal and six assists with the Winterhawks in 24 games. He led all Portland rookies with four assists in the first-round of the WHL Playoffs. He was previously ranked No. 8 on the International Skaters midseason list before arriving in Portland.

Ryan Miller, a 5-foot-11, 174-pound left winger from Medicine Hat, Alberta, has risen up the rankings from his midterm ranking of No. 118 among North American skaters to No. 60. In his second full WHL season, Miller has embraced a leadership role with the Winterhawks, wearing an 'A' as an alternate captain, the first time in at least 20 years a 17-year-old has worn a letter for Portland. During the regular season, he recorded 16 goals, 15 assists, and 31 points in 50 games played. Through ten games in the 2025 WHL Playoffs, Miller has two goals and seven assists. **Diego Buttazzoni** also impressed the scouts during the second half of the season, jumping to No. 141 from No. 191 in the midterm rankings. The 5-foot-9, 183-pound forward netted a career-best 38 goals, 39 assists, and 77 points during his third season with the Winterhawks. On the power play, his shot was a force to be reckoned with as he put 16 man-advantage goals behind opposing netminders. Buttazzoni's strong play has carried into the postseason, where he is a point-per-game player (6G, 4A) in ten contests.

FOURTH STRAIGHT TRIP TO ROUND TWO... With the team's 4-3 series win over Prince George, the Portland Winterhawks advanced to the second round of the WHL playoffs for a fourth consecutive season. That's the longest active streak in the WHL and tied for the longest active streak in the CHL (Kitchener) of program's to advance to the second round of its league playoffs. Additionally, the Hawks are playing in the Western Conference Championship Series in back-to-back years for the first time since 2013 and 2014.

WICKED WEIERMAIR... Alex Weiermair dazzled with six goals in the opening round of the 2025 WHL Playoffs, including his first career WHL hat trick in a Game 3 win. That's the most goals by a 19-year-old, first-year player in a playoff series. The previous record was five goals by Jiri Beranek in six games in 1992 vs. Seattle.

JUGNAUTH MAKES HISTORY... Tyson Jugnauth registered an assist on Portland's power-play goal in Game 5 of the opening-round series to bring his playoff point totals to 13 and setting a record in the process. Jugnauth's 16 points (2G, 14A) in the series against Prince George surpassed Jeff Finley for most by a defenseman in any playoff series in franchise history. Finley's 12 points (1G, 11A) came over eight games (best-of-nine series) in 1987 vs. Kamloops. Jugnauth also set the Winterhawks playoff record for most assists (14) in a single series and his 16 points in the series is 2nd all-time for any player in a playoff series, tying Ken Yaremchuk. Jeff Rohlicek had 20 points during the 1984 playoffs.

ROUND 1, GAME 4 RECORDS... Portland's Game 4 victory in the opening round of the WHL Playoffs was the longest game in team history, spanning 97 minutes and 57 seconds into double overtime. The previous high was 96:21 set on March 28, 2003 against the Spokane Chiefs on the road (Portland won 2-1). Thus, Ondřej Štěbeták (96:51) surpassed Krister Toews (96:21) record of most minutes played by a goaltender in a game. Štěbeták's 49-save performance also set a postseason record for most saves at home, surpassing Brent Belecki's 43-save night on March 31, 1996. Plus, second-year forward Ryan Miller scored a goal 19:36 into the third period in Game 4 to tie the game at 4-4, the latest goal in playoff history on home ice to force overtime.

FIRST TEAM ALL STARS... Portland Winterhawks captain Kyle Chyzowski and alternate captain Tyson Jugnauth were named Western Conference First-Team All Stars for their terrific 20-year-old season.

Chyzowski, 20, led the team in scoring and ranked fourth in the WHL this season with 105 points. After leading the team in goals (9) in the 2024 playoffs, the native of Surrey, British Columbia, picked up right where he left off. Chyzowski shattered his previous career-highs in goals (41), power-play goals (10), shorthanded goals (4), assists (64), and points (105). During his five-year tenure with Portland, Chyzowski registered 90 goals, 141 assists, and 231 points, along with a +37 rating in 273 regular season games. His 231 career points rank 28th on the Winterhawks all-time scoring list. Portland selected the 5-foot-10, 171-pound centerman in the third round of the 2019 WHL Prospects Draft.

Jugnauth, 20, joined the Winterhawks last season on December 9, 2023, after Portland acquired his rights from the Kamloops Blazers. Selected in the 4th round of the 2022 NHL Entry Draft by the Seattle Kraken, Jugnauth led the entire WHL in scoring among defensemen with 13 goals, 76 assists, and 89 points, 17 more than anyone else. Jugnauth produced in all situations: shorthanded (1G, 3A), power play (6G, 35A), and even strength (6G, 38A). He was named the team's co-defensive player of the year. In 106 regular-season games in the Rose City, the Kelowna, British Columbia, native has amassed 20 goals, 110 assists, and 130 points, along with a +49 rating.

AND THE NOMINEES ARE... In addition to being named Western Conference First-Team All Stars, Portland Winterhawks captain Kyle Chyzowski and alternate captain Tyson Jugnauth were nominated for prestigious end-of-season awards on April 10, 2025.

Chyzowski, 20, was named a Western Conference finalist for the Four Broncos Memorial Trophy, which is awarded annually to the WHL's Player of the Year. His 105 regular-season points ranked 4th in the league, and at the time of the nomination, his 14 playoff points were also tied for third. He is looking to become the first Winterhawks since Joachim Blichfeld (114 points in 2017-18) to win the Four Broncos Memorial Trophy. Jugnauth, 20, was nominated as a Western Conference finalist for the Bill Hunter Memorial Trophy, awarded annually to the WHL's Defenseman of the Year. The Kelowna, British Columbia native finished the 2024-2025 WHL regular season with 13 goals, 76 assists, and 89 points to lead all blueliners, 17 more than his next closest competitor. Jugnauth finished one point shy of joining former Winterhawk defenseman Luca Cagnoni as the only WHL defenseman since 1993-1994 to reach the 90-point mark. At the time of the nomination, Jugnauth was tied for first in playoff scoring with 16 points after the club's first-round series win. He's looking to become the first Winterhawks since Derrick Pouliot (2013-14) to claim the award as league's top defenseman.

HUMANITARIAN McDONOUGH... The Western Hockey League announced that Portland Winterhawks second-year forward Kyle McDonough has been named the Humanitarian of the Year. The 18-year-old skater participated in a player-high eighteen (18) community events throughout the 2024-2025 regular season, including multiple visits to the Boys and Girls Club Portland, school rinks, elementary schools, and Toyota Tom's Tykes learn-to-skate sessions. What hits closest to Kyle's heart is his work with DSP Connections, an organization serving children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. His aunt has Prader-Willi Syndrome (PWS), and he's dedicated much of his life to supporting and caring for her. Whether he is first to volunteering events on

Jordan Duguay scored his first career WHL goal in the Hawks season opener in Kamloops on September 20. **Carsyn Dyck** and **Reed Brown** each netted their first career WHL goal on Saturday, September 21 in Kelowna. Alternate captain **Ryder Thompson** laced up in his 200th career regular-season game during the Hawks' home opener on October 4. **Marek Schlenker** made his WHL debut against Prince George on October 5, stopping 38 of 40 shots to secure his first win as a Hawk. **David Hoy**, a product of Fort St. James, B.C. just over an hour and a half north of Prince George, scored his first WHL points thanks to his primary assist on October 8 in Prince George. He netted his first WHL goal later that month in an October 26th home game against Edmonton. **Kyle Chyzowski** secured his 150th career WHL points on November 9 in Wenatchee. He recorded four points in the win, including a shorthanded goal to reach the milestone. **Josh Zakreski** netted his first career hat trick on November 29 and also surpassed 100 career points in the same game. **Diego Buttazzoni** scored twice against Vancouver on December 7. His first goal (the eventual game-winning goal) of the night was his 100th career point in the WHL. **Alex Weiermair** made his WHL debut on December 7 and scored his first WHL goal, assist, and multipoint game in the effort. **Joel Plante** made his Winterhawks debut on December 13 against the Prince George Cougars and he recorded his first career point via an assist the next night on December 14 against Seattle. With an assist on December 17, **Kyle Chyzowski** surpassed 100 career assists with the Winterhawks.

Joel Plante scored his first WHL goal, the eventual game-winning goal, on January 2 against Spokane. **Lochlan Tetarenko** made his Winterhawks debut on January 15 against his former club in Saskatoon. **Kyle Chyzowski** dressed in his 250th career WHL game on January 17 in Moose Jaw, becoming the 36th Winterhawk all-time to reach 250 WHL games. In that same game, **Tyson Jugnauth** secured two assists to bring his career point totals up to 100. **Max Pšenička** skated in his first career WHL game on January 24 against Tri-City, registering an assist in the win. **Kyle Chyzowski** recorded his 200th career point in that same game thanks to a three assist performance. **Hudson Darby** laced up in his 100th career WHL game on February 8 against Seattle. **Ryder Thompson** skated in his 250th career WHL game and **Kyle McDonough** is dressed in his 100th on February 21 in Everett. **Josh Zakreski** played in his 200th career WHL game on February 23. Seattle Kraken prospect **Tyson Jugnauth** recorded his 100th career assist on February 26 in Kamloops and he's skated in his 100th career WHL game on March 7. **Kyle Chyzowski** locked up a 100 point season with an assist on March 9 against Everett. **Carter Sotheran** dressed in his 200th career game on March 22 in Seattle.

off days, personally connecting with fans at meet-the-team events, or making everyone around him feel included, McDonough never hesitates to step up. To the Langdon, Alberta, native, this award is not just an honor but rather a reflection of the values he lives by every day.

IRON MAN... Winterhawks rookie Jordan Duguay achieved iron man status for dressing in all 68 regular-season games. Ryder Thompson (67) would have been the second player to join Duguay, however, the coaches elected to rest him in the team's final game of the regular season because the team was locked into the No.5 seed in the Western Conference. Thus, Duguay is the only Winterhawk to play in every game this season and just the sixth 16 year old in franchise history to accomplish that. He joins Andrew Ference (1995-96), Rick Davidson (1983-84), Ken Yaremchuk (1980-81), Peter Derksen (1980-81), and Gary Nylund (1979-80) as the only other 16 year olds to skate in every regular season contest.

AWARD SEASON... The Portland Winterhawks handed out it's end-of-season team awards ahead of the team's final regular-season home game on March 21. All awards were voted upon by the team except the Leading Scorer, Winterhawk Award, and the Portland Winterhawks Booster Club Player of the Year Award.

NOTABLES: The Winterhawk Award, presented by the coaching staff, recognizes the player who best exemplifies character, leadership, and heart & soul. For the first time in 49 years of Winterhawks hockey, there is a back-to-back-to-back winner: Ryder Thompson, who was deservedly named the 2024-2025 recipient. His dedication to the organization began when he left Manitoba as a 16-year-old during the shortened 2020-2021 season.

SHORTHANDED HEROES... The Portland Winterhawks finished the regular season with a WHL-leading 18 shorthanded goals, one shy of tying their franchise record of 19 in a single season. The team previously scored 19 shorthanded goals during both the 1997-98 season and 1986-87 campaign. It was done by committee this season as nine different Winterhawks scored while on the penalty kill. Kyle Chyzowski led the WHL with nine shorthanded points (4G-5A) this season and he's also tied for the franchise lead in the Internet Era with 17 points (6G-11A) while shorthanded, joining former teammate Marcus Nguyen (13G-4A) and Taylor Peters (10G-7A).

MR. MILESTONE... Winterhawks captain Kyle Chyzowski notched three assists in the January 24 win against Tri-City to propel him to 201 career regular-season points and counting. He became just the 38th Winterhawk all-time to achieve that milestone, following in the footsteps of last year's leaders Gabe Klassen and James Stefan. On March 9, he assisted the Hawks first goal of the game against Everett to secure his first 100-point season. Thanks to the milestone, Chyzowski entered the Winterhawks' top 30 all-time scorers. He recently passed Brandon Dubinsky, Joachim Blichfeld, and Glen Wesley on the all-time list to rank 28th with 231 career points.

For family comparisons, his cousin Ryan produced 217 career WHL points and his other cousin Nick netted 134 points, his uncle Dave had 144 WHL points and his other under Ron plus his dad Barry played NCAA hockey.

BEST DRESSED... Winterhawks alternate captain Ryder Thompson skated in his 250th career WHL regular-season game on February 21 in Everett and he even scored in the milestone game. He became the 11th Winterhawks defenseman all-time to lace up in 250+ games, most recently 2021-22 captain Clay Hanus. Originally selected by the Winterhawks in the fifth round of the 2015 WHL Prospects Draft, Thompson has more than doubled his goal scoring production with nine goals this year. He is a three-time recipient of the Winterhawk Award, given annually to the Winterhawk who embodies character, leadership, heart and soul.

THE 20s LOCK IN NCAA COMMITMENTS... All thee Winterhawks 20 year olds are committed to play NCAA hockey during the 2025-26 season. Captain Kyle Chyzowski is set to attend Denver University, alternate captain Ryder Thompson will enroll at Miami (Ohio) University, and alternate captain Tyson Jugnauth will return to the Big Ten to play at Michigan State University. Chyzowski was originally selected by Portland in the third round of the 2019 WHL Prospects Draft, Thompson went in the fifth round of the 2019 draft, and Tyson Jugnauth joined the Winterhawks from the University of Wisconsin in December 2023.
