Job Responsibilities:

- Ensure game elements are set up with direction from Entertainment and Operation personnel.
- Coordinate cohesively with other departments to execute entertainment.
- Facilitate with game elements, including but are not limited to interacting with fans/contestants, setting up gameday promotions, coordinating with entertainment team on concourse, pregame, and intermission activations.
- Support general game night entertainment or marketing department projects and programs as needed.
- Assist other departments such as ticketing, merchandise, sponsorship, or VIP fan experience when needed.
- Provide additional support during Winterhawks special events.

REQUIREMENTS

- College student or recent graduate.
- Ability to work in fast-paced environment.
- Ability to attend majority of home games during the season, including evenings, weekends, and holidays.
- Maintain regular and consistent attendance and punctuality.
- Strong work ethic and a willingness to learn and accept all tasks assigned.
- Ability to work independently or in a group during set up and to get tasks done quickly.
- Ability to handle the physical requirements of the position, including setting up equipment for events,
- Standing for long periods of time and other light to medium lifting.
- Ability to communicate effectively with management and guests.
